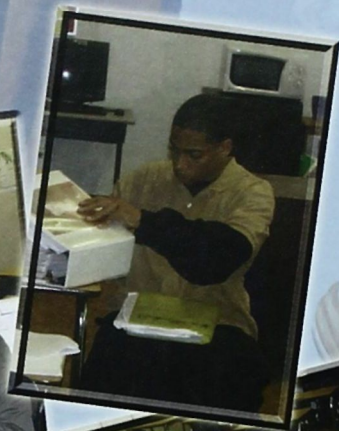

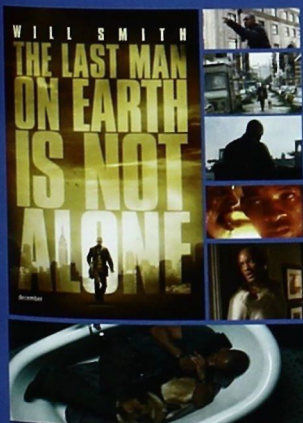


I Am Legend

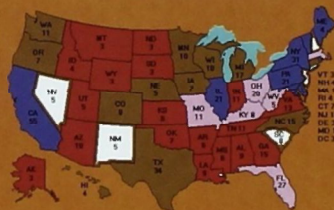

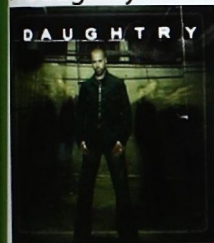

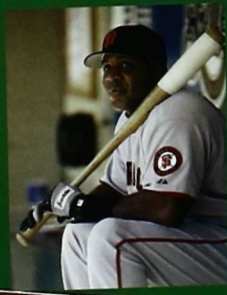

Blank Blu-ray disc- roughly \$25.00

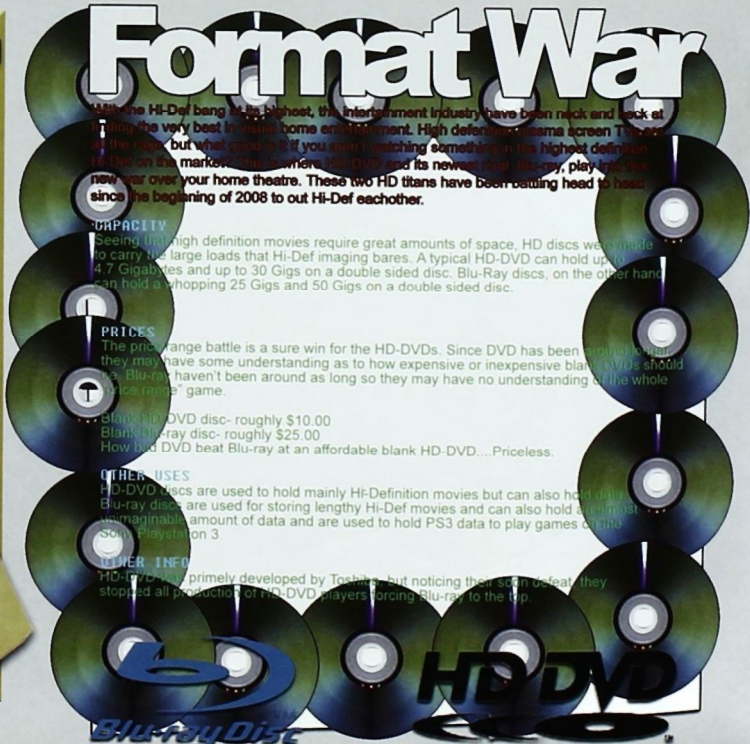

OTHER INFO

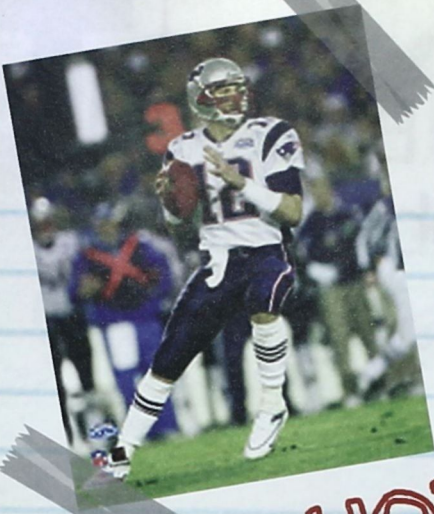
HD-DVD was primarily developed by Toshiba, but noticing their soon defeat, they stopped all production of HD-DVD players forcing Blu-ray to the top.
