The Kaiserslautern High School chapter of National Honor Society was established in September 1997, under the leadership of then principal, Dr. J. Richard Dewey. The official motto is "Noblesse Oblige" which means nobility obliges. Our chapter of NHS holds Scholarship, Service, Leadership and Character as core beliefs to its foundation.


## Project Horizon

Project Horizon is based on a satellite model called CubeSats, which are very small satellites, exactly one unit in size and are sent 30 km into the troposphere. At this altitude, the pressure is $1 \% \mathrm{kpa}$. This mimics the pressure of the surface of Mars. They can even use this to test the ozone layer and capture images or videos.



NTHS was introduced to KHS in the 2016-2017 school year. The goal is to create projects (currently Project Horizon) that would benefit the KMC. These projects have been changed from the original concept of many projects to focusing all efforts on one project.

## Tech Club

Tech club does a variety of different projects to better K-Town. Tech Club worked on developing an app recently that would give you notifications for everything, much like Schoology. However, this project was sadly discontinued.

Provinces, states and cities continued to implement strict measures to slow the spread of the virus. The movement, called "flatten the curve" prompted entertainment, bar and restaurant closures across the US

 and Canada. By Monday, all NBA, PGA, MLB, MLS, NASCAR, NHL, and NGAA sporting events were either canceled or put on hold for two or more weeks. Some especially hard hit areas, including seven counties in California, put a three-week-long "Shelter in Place" home restriction on citizens, requiring they leave their homes only for essential needs. Workers in essential services (emergency and medical, banks, grocery, pharmacy and food service) were exempted from the restriction, so they could work.In the midst of a pandemic, the Centers for Disease Control sends a strong message:


KNOW HOW - There is currently no vaccine to prevent Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
IT SPREADS - The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.

- The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person.
- Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
-Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.

TAKE STEPS - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds TO PROTECT YOURSELF especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60\% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Put distance between yourself and other people if COVID-19 is spreading in your community. This is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.

TAKE STEPS • Stay home if you are sick, except to get medical care. Learn what to TO PROTECT OTHERS do if you are sick.

- Cover coughs and sneezes.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
- Throw used tissues in the trash.
- Immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, clean your hands with a hand sanitizer that contains at least $60 \%$ alcohol.
- If you are sick: You should wear a facemask when you are around other people (e.g., sharing a room or vehicle) and before you enter a healthcare provider's office. If you are not able to wear a facemask (for example, because it causes trouble breathing), then you should
