# TIMELINE <br> ENTERTANMENT COVID-19 DISRUPTS STAGE \& SCREEN 

The entertainment industry is hit hard by the pandemic. Studios are forced to shut down or delay production of TV shows and films in many countries. Movies already slated for release are stymied by closed theaters and ordinances against crowds. The only saving graces are streaming services who add millions of subscribers. But even they can't sustain an industry that relies on an audience.


No Time to Die
The highly anticipated 25th installment of the James Bond franchise, "No Time To Die", is the first major studio movie release to be delayed due to COVID-19. The film's release date is initially pushed from April 2020 to November 2020, then April 2021 with speculation that it could fall victim to further delays.


Delayed release dates coupled with fear of infection choke out the movie industry. With neither movies nor moviegoers coming to theaters, the industry falls into sharp decline, forcing cinemas to close doors and studios to release new titles direct-to-streaming.
