Tommy Sutton leaves his coordination in all sports to Richard Kane, his straight hair to Tim Winslow, and his hip huggers to John Brown.

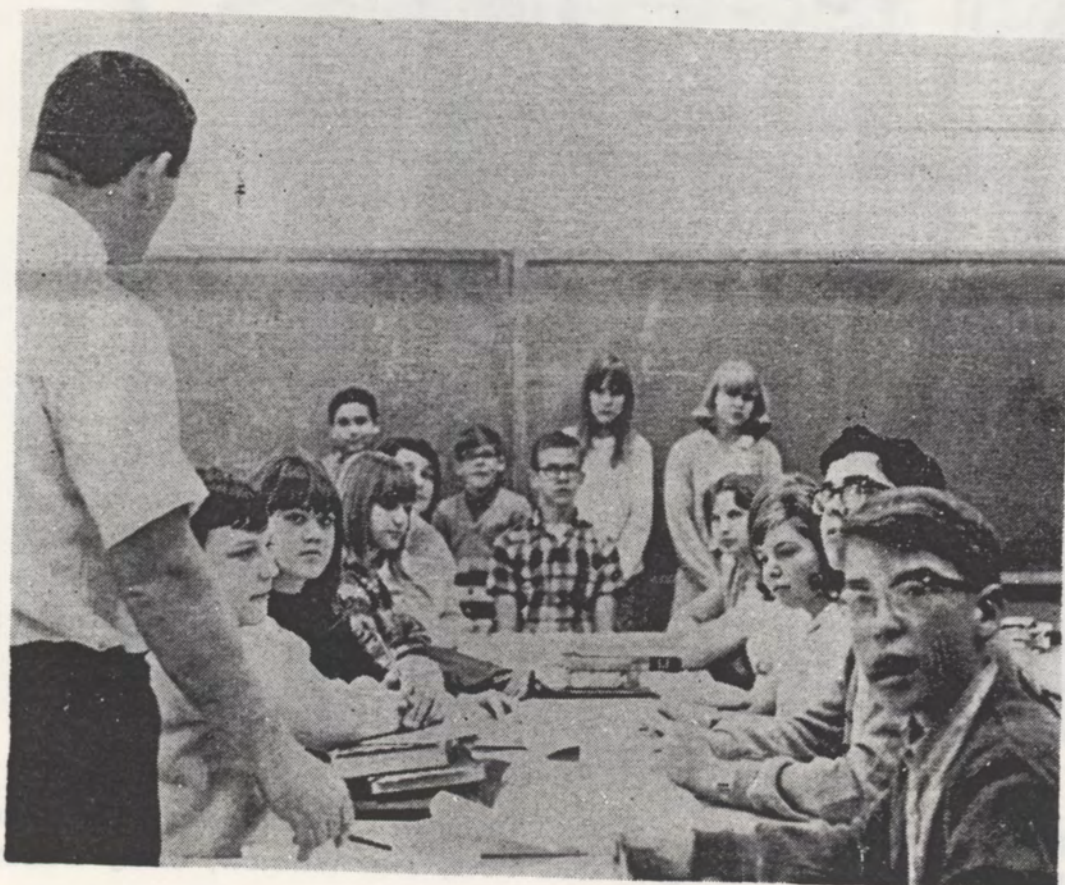
