




Unfortunately, injuries to the two top runners, Churchill and Lindenmuth, kept them from peak performances in the Regionals and USDESEA finals in Germany.


Unfortunately, the Regional Tournament had to be cancelled, but six of our wrestlers were selected to go to Germany and compete in the USDESEA finals.
