






TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY YOUTH - A SIXTEENTH CENTURY SETTING

Honors Reading-Discussion


Two new programs at Lajes High School; Work-Study and Eighth Grade Honors reading, are meeting the needs of more students at their area of interest.
