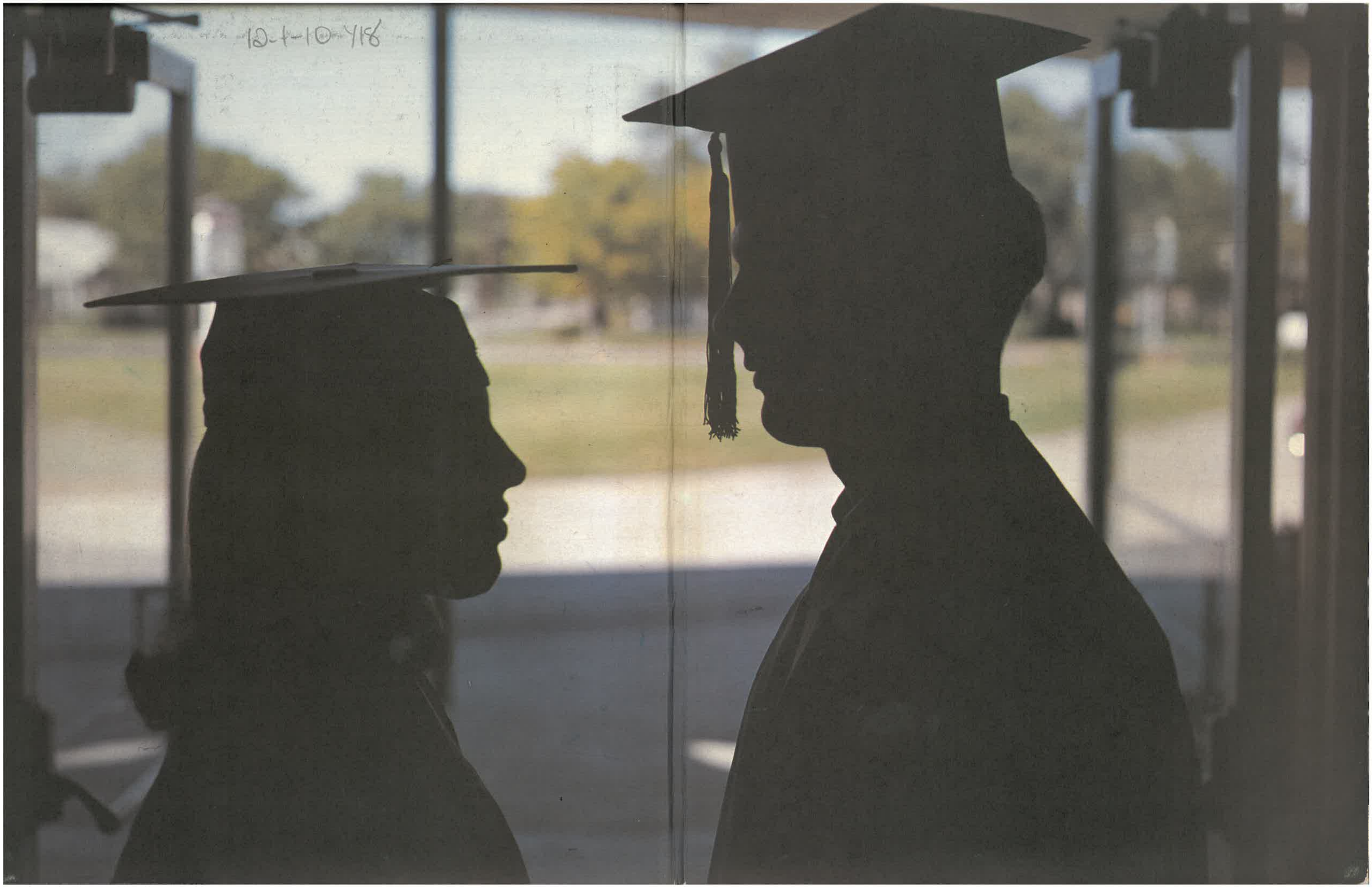

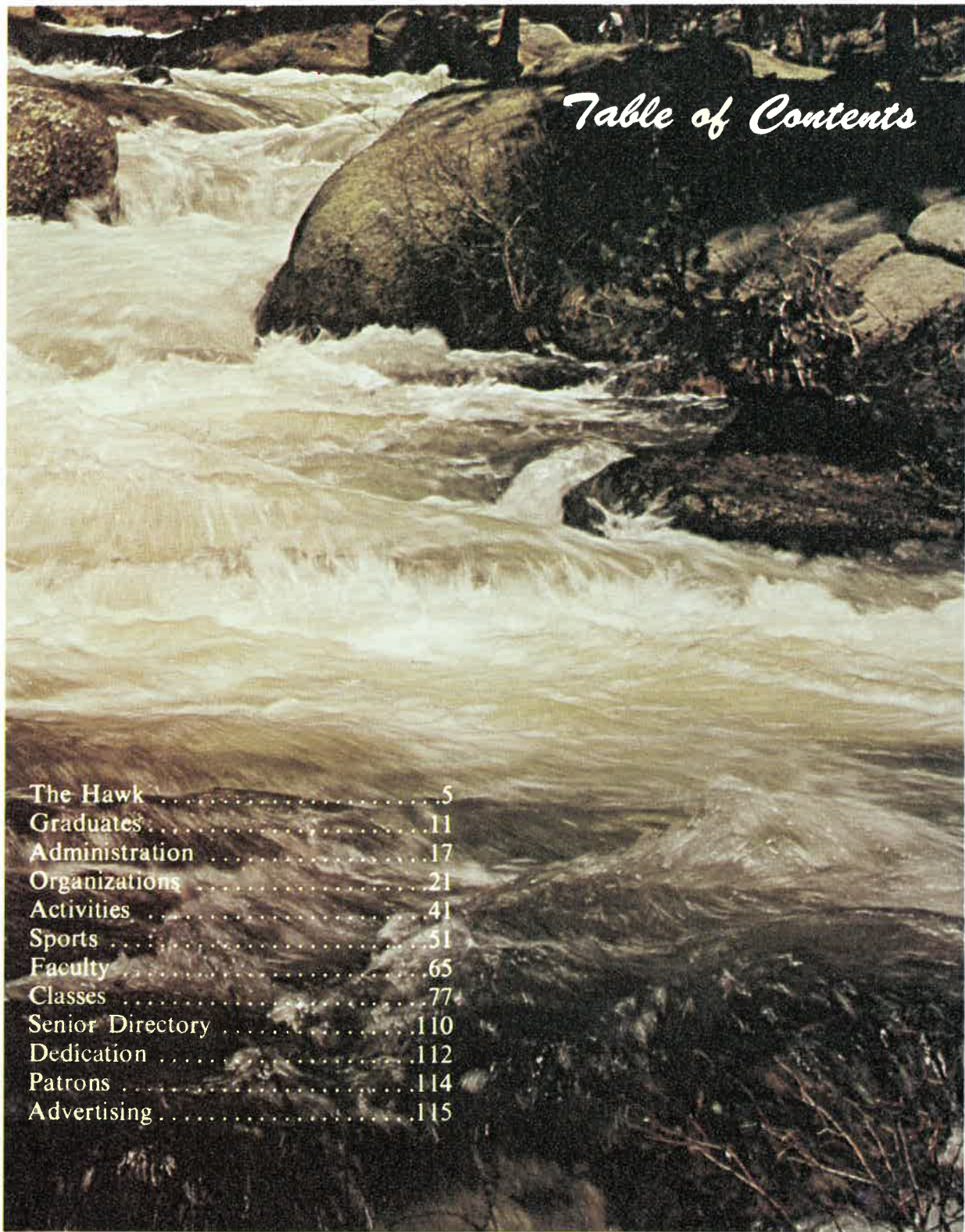


TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY YOUTH - A SIXTEENTH CENTURY SETTING
