the 1973 falcons coached by roger youngman easily cut through this year's competition to finish 8-3 in 11 encounters.


starting the season with a win over headquarters, the falcons showed the ability and determination needed to capture the championship title.

this year saw a lot of teamwork. the team was outstanding individually and collectively. yes, we are number one!






workshop




