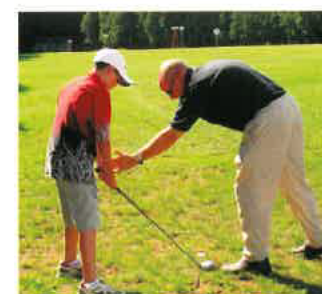

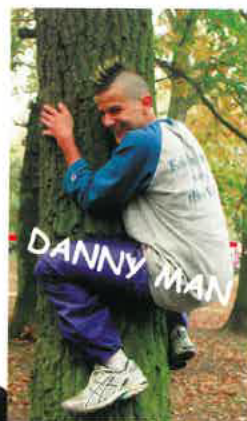

Say "I love you" to your dad. When in proximity, go for the hug, too!

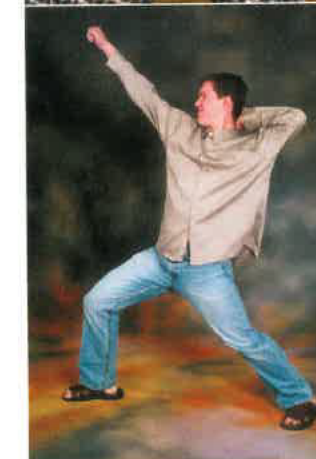
Proper prior planning prevents poor performance.
