work for girls and women of all ages. All work is done by hand and takes much time and patience. The many steps involved in making a finished product are the designing, printing, embroidering, washing, ironing, sewing and folding of the linen. Each woman works an eight hour day.

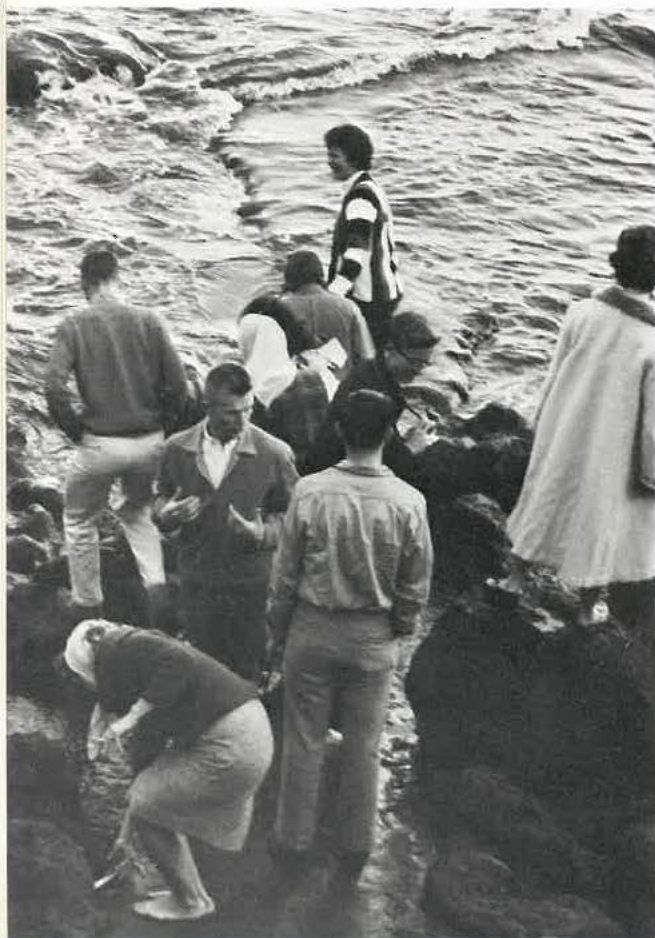
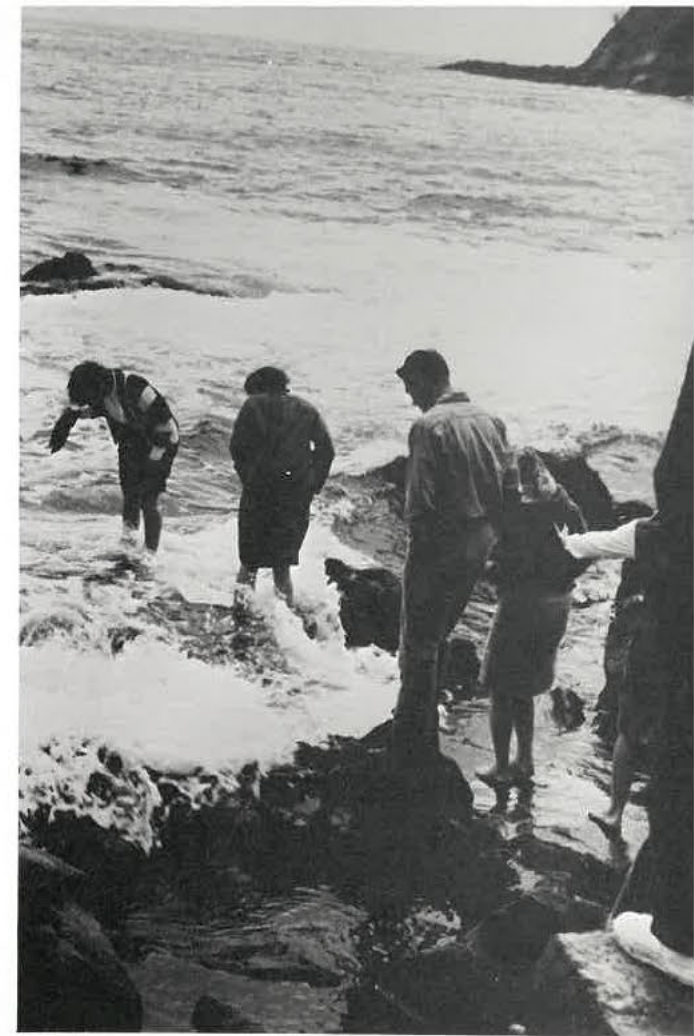
The roads on the island are of stone laid and smoothed by hand. Therefore, for the average Portuguese, the horse and cart offer adequate transportation. Other modes of travel include cars, bicycles and donkey.

Since the island has a tropical climate, fresh fruits are always available. Venders may sell them on the road side or they may be bought in markets. The price is low, but the quality high.

The island was once a volcano. Consequently, the shores are jagged pieces of solidified lava. There are many beaches, however, and many spots that offer a "quick wade" for water lovers.

All in all, life upon the "Third Hawk" of Terceira, Azores, Portugal, can be one filled with interest and new adventures for those willing to look for them.

Life in the Azores offers an opportunity for an understanding of new customs and language and may bring satisfaction and excitement to the seeker.

Terceira is the third largest island of the group of nine and was also the third to be discovered. This is how it received its name. Visitors to its shores included the famed Christopher Columbus, who stopped here on his return voyage from the "New World."

Corn is the staff of life. It grows in abundance, is harvested, bundled and put on large wooden frames for drying and storing. These are nearly always located next to the owner's house. Typical of the houses are the tile roofs, cement walls of pale shades and brightly trimmed windows and doors.

Along with farming, the Portuguese people depend on cattle raising and linen goods for livelihoods. The large linen factory, located in Angra, offers
