The Jason Project was started by Dr. Bob Ballard, who discovered the Titanic. The program offers students the opportunity to participate via telecommunications with scientists at the site of the study. The site for this year's expedition was Hawaii. Livorno students spent two months studying the Hawaiian eco-system, biology, geology, volcanism, and astronomy. They then traveled to the PIN site at RAF Lakenheath where they participated in evening programs and competed to ask questions via computer and satellite hook-ups with the scientists.
