1952-2007

"Livorno School opened when Camp Darby was established as a support base in 1952 for the American troops stationed in Austria at the height of the Cold War. The first school was a Kindergarten through 12th grade school located in a house in the community of Ardenza with only two teachers. Secondary students took correspondence courses, initially conducted by parents, and later by a full-time teacher. When the Mediterranean Division of the Corps of Engineers arrived in 1954, the enrollment increased considerably and the school moved to the Hotel Corallo across from the Livorno railroad station. In 1958 the high school was transferred to Camp Darby where the current school building has been since that time. The first graduating class was the class of 1965 with six graduates. In 1970 there were 42 graduates. Four graduates will represent the graduating class of 2007 at the final graduation ceremony for Livorno School." ~ Cathy Magni, Principal

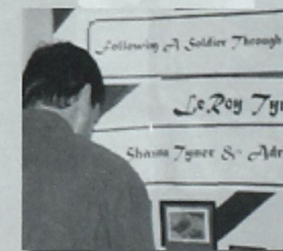
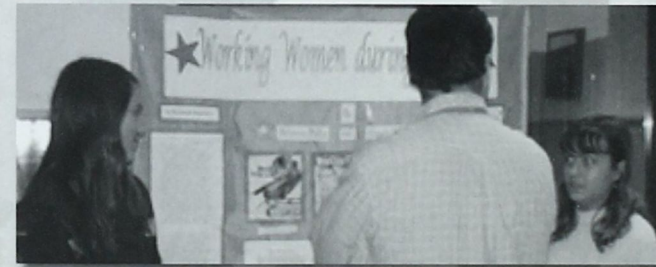
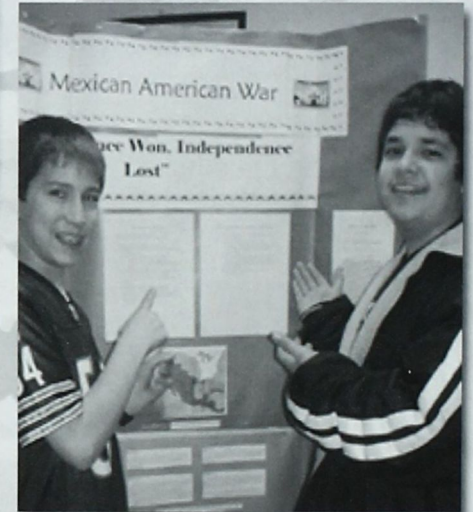
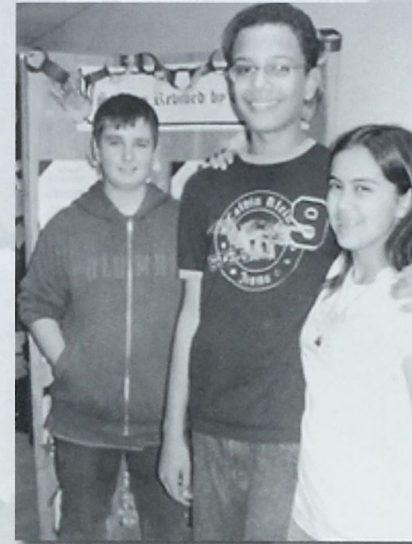
National History Day

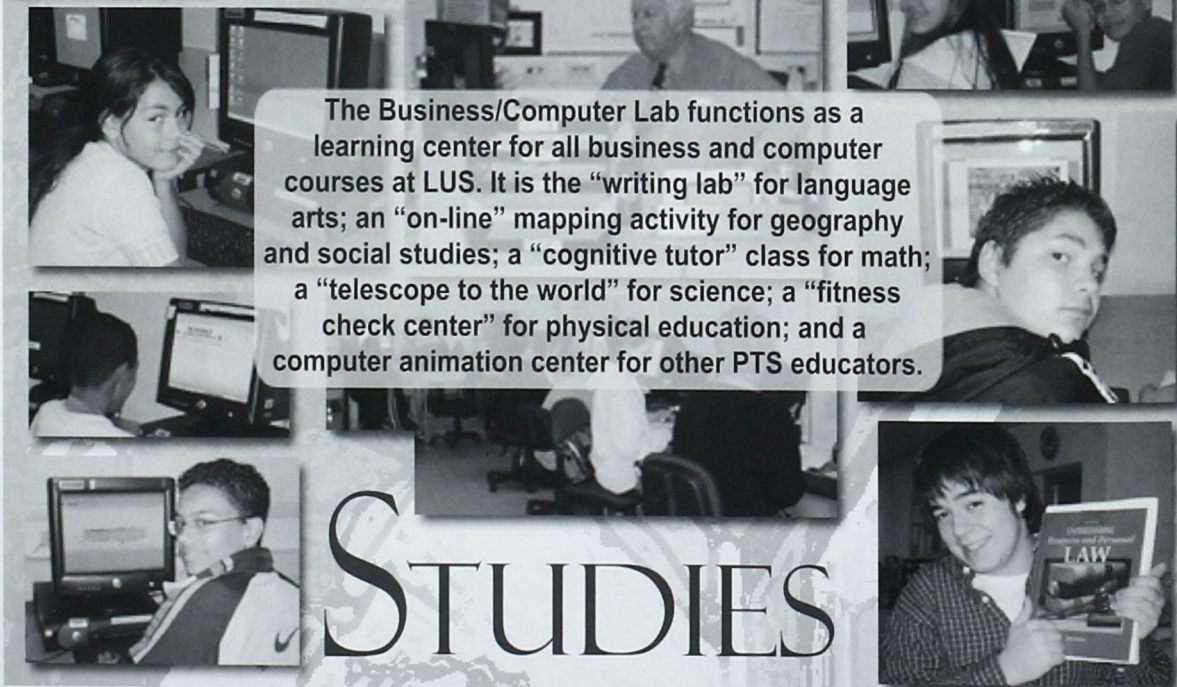
Lions Unlimited created videos for the school and AFN. Students interviewed teachers, students and staff for the end of the year CD and took photos and taped all the school events.

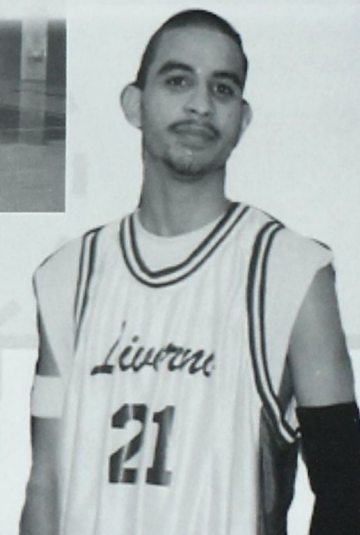
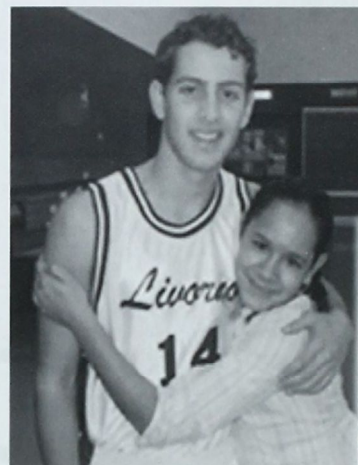


BASKETBALL


Well done on completing another rigorous academic year full of learning, growth and new experiences. I am as proud of your many accomplishments as your parents and teachers.

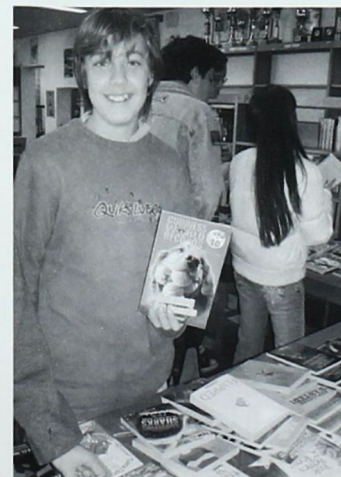

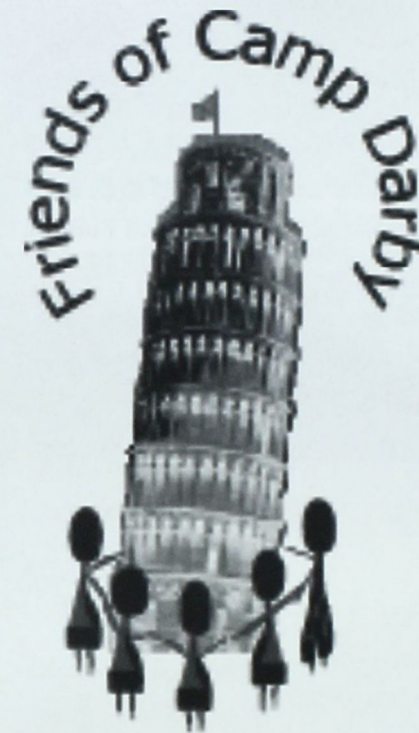


