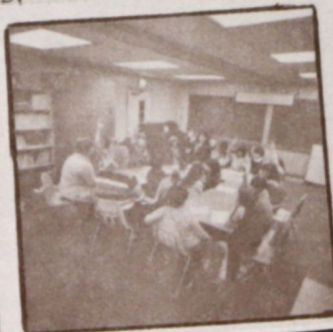
Student Council
