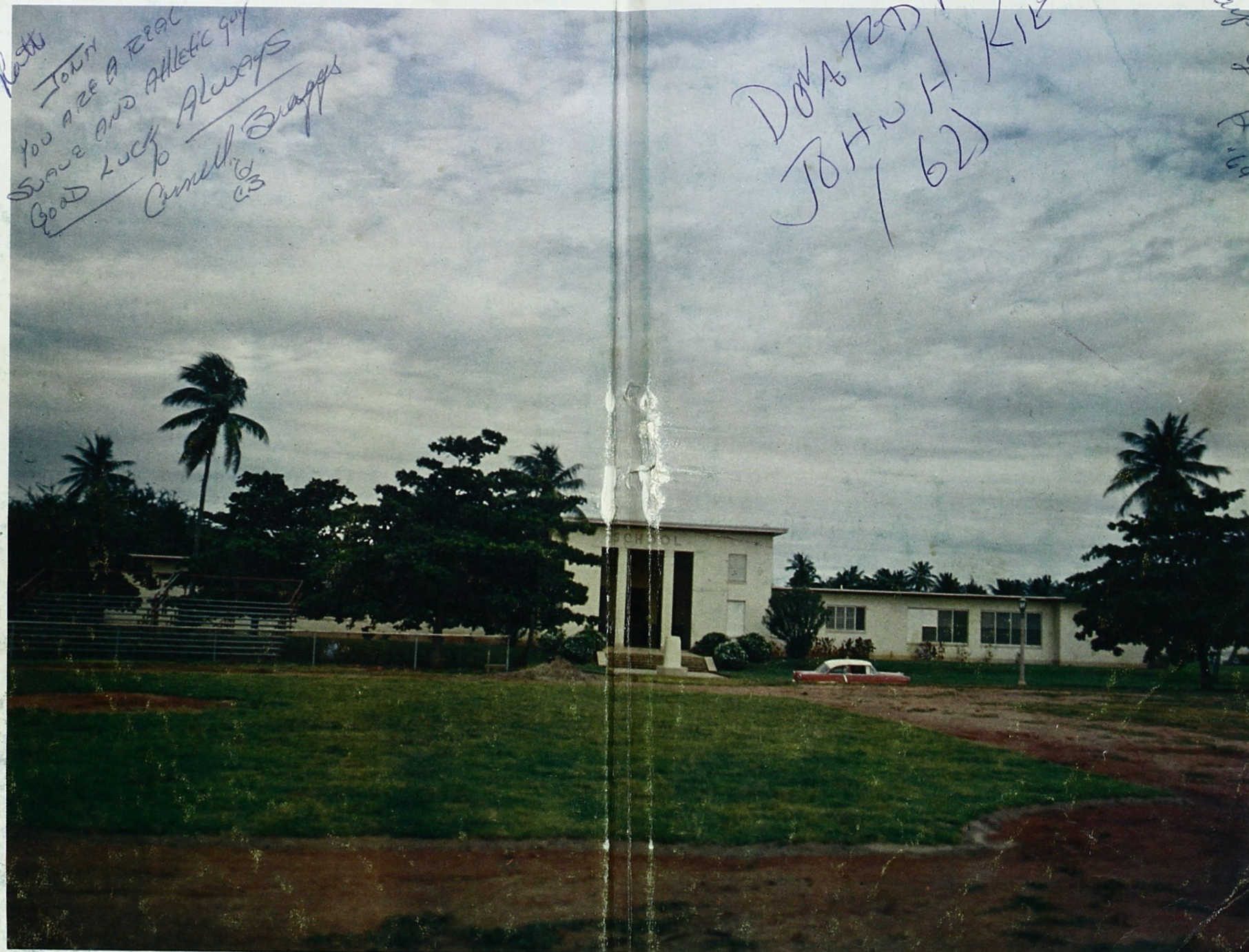

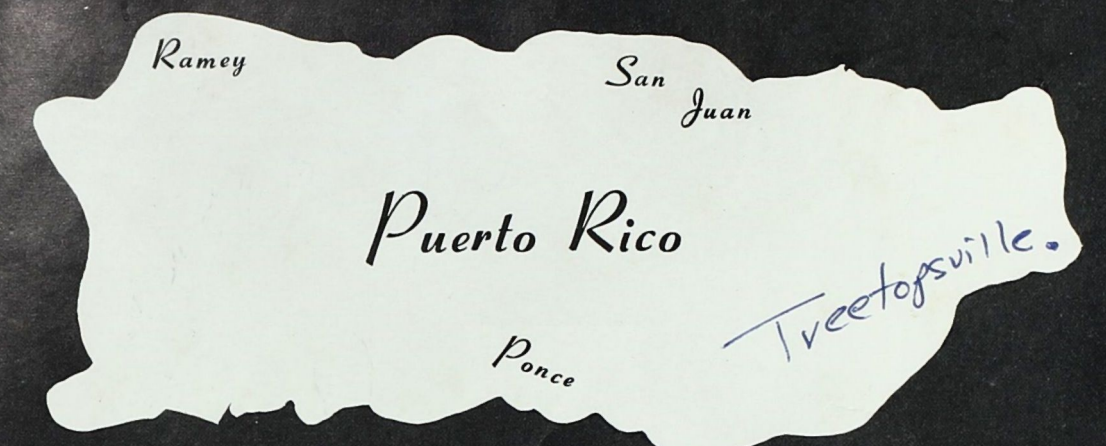

We take this occasion to thank them for providing us with a fine opportunity to further our education and for the experiences of living and working in Puerto Rico.

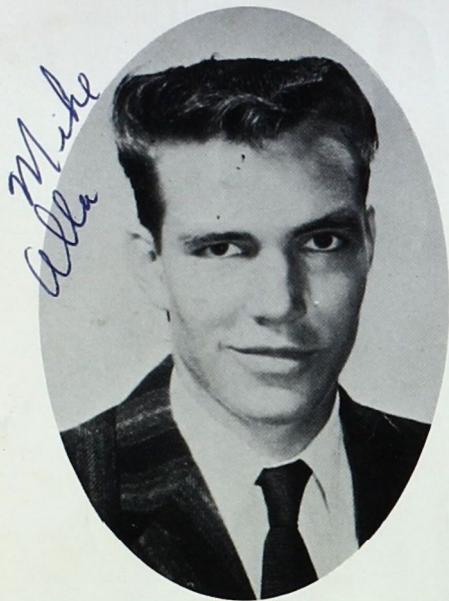
