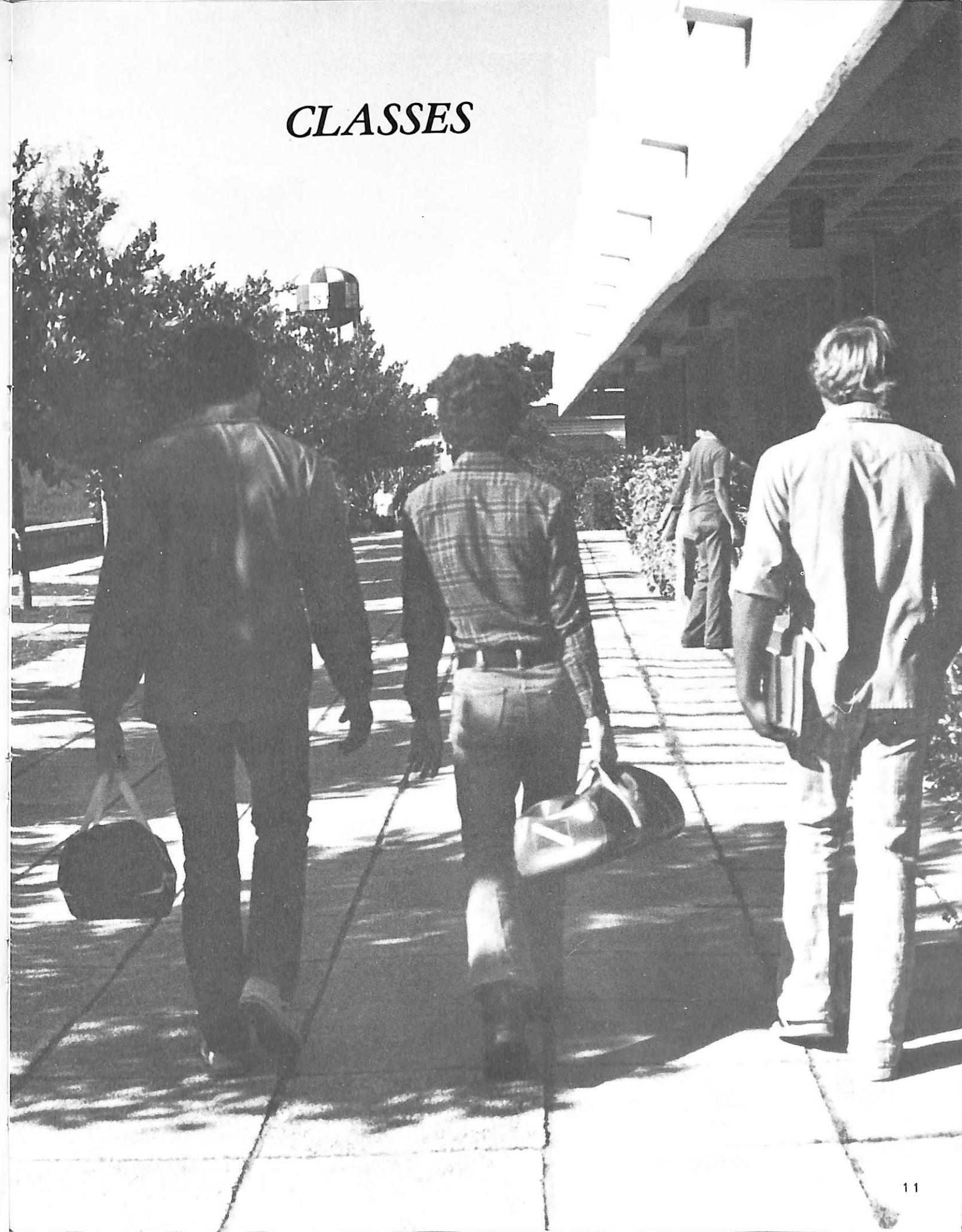
In Memoria...

Major Percy L. Williams, USAF (ret.), a teacher at Ramey for several years, passed away on March 10, 1978. He was a quiet, soft-spoken individual who was dedicated to his country and its high ideals. He strove to impress these ideals on all whom he met, both in and out of the classroom. He will be long remembered by large numbers of Ramey students, past and present.

On the 15th of March, 1978, Major Williams was buried with full military honors at Arlington National Cemetery. At the same moment, the students and faculty of Ramey paid him tribute as the flag was lowered to half-mast to the beautiful notes of "taps" played by Mr. Snyder.
