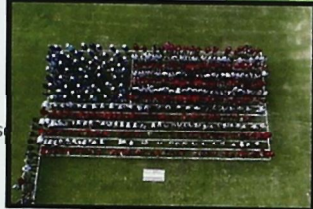

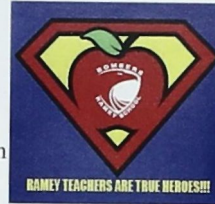

This year Ramey and all DoDEA schools were going through accreditation process. On November we had an internal Review. After a day going through classroom observations, this is what was said in the meeting:

There is "a lot to be celebrated and obvious shared leadership at Ramey."

Collaboration:

- *It is not just between teachers, but students as well.
- *Can see it in how students talk to each other
- *Children were continuously collaborating, problem-solving in a seamless manner
- *Children comfortably switched collaborative partners when seeking assistance or clarification
- *Students worked together to problem-solve

Supportive Relationships

- *Students reported they felt very well supported by the teachers
- *They reported being very well supported by other adults, as well
- *The whole school supports each other
- *The Inclusion model for Special education students is visible, active and effective

Self-directed students

- *Students have personal goals
- *Rubrics and "I can statements" help in this self-directed learning.

Even the digital piece, so long a thorn in the thigh of accreditation, received praise for its seamless integration through stations and student choice.

Students have been showing support for the victims affected by the earthquakes and want to develop a positive outcome from the natural disaster. Thank you for the support and help with everything.



On January 7, 2020, the last day of winter break, well that's what we thought, at exactly 4:24 a.m. of this day, Puerto Rico suffered from one of the biggest earthquakes in the history of Puerto Rico, its magnitude was of 6.6. Everyone in the island was left without power. Ramey was left without power for a week so that meant that our winter break was forced to extend one more week. The south area of Puerto Rico was mostly affected, but we felt it strong in Aguadilla. Hundreds of people lost their homes, school buildings, churches and fastfoods were destroyed. There were hundreds of aftershock. People were frightened to be in their houses. Everyone in the South decided to put tents and live outside. The aftershocks lasted for a little less than two months. Ramey always is present in times like these. Many went out to the south to help the people. Everyone at Ramey donated supplies!!

Mr. Proskauer and Ms. Valerio would go get supplies (a lot of people at Ramey donated too) and headed out to Guanica where they would find elderly, people with special needs and many families having to live on parking lots under tents because they lost everything after the earthquake.

How COVID-19 changed our lives

Nov. 2019

A novel coronavirus was first identified in China's Hubei province. The disease it causes attacks the lungs and causes rapid onset of pneumonia in already immunocompromised patients.

The World Health Organization (WHO) names the virus SARS-CoV-2 (Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus 2) and the disease it causes COVID-19 (Coronavirus Disease 2019). Worldwide death toll is 1,107.

The first American case was diagnosed in Washington state. The illness rapidly spread across the globe, endangering mostly older adults and those with underlying and chronic health conditions, including lung disease, heart disease and diabetes.

March

Canada had 118 cases. United States had 1,267 cases. Italy had more than 12,000 cases. The WHO declared SARS-CoV-2 a pandemic, which meant the 118,000 cases and more than 4,000 deaths worldwide required more specific and targeted attention and resources. To slow the virus's spread, the US suspended European travel for 30 days.

12 Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and wife Sophie Grégoire Trudeau self-isolated after she experienced symptoms. He was cleared, but she had the virus.

16 US states closed schools to reduce spread of the virus: Alabama, West Virginia, New Mexico, Wisconsin, Rhode Island, Oregon, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Ohio, Louisiana, Utah, Kentucky, Rhode Island, Washington, Michigan.

14 The US reported 7,818 confirmed cases and 58 deaths. Fifteen states activated National Guard troops to assist with virus-related concerns, including regulating the flow of medical supplies, food and shelter. Canadian provinces canceled schools as the numbers of infected rose.

Canada reported 341 cases. More cases were reported outside mainland China than inside it for the first time in the history of the disease. The largest school district in the US, NYC Public Schools, closed. The CDC suggested a community bank on all gatherings of more than 50 people for at least eight weeks.

Provinces, states and cities continued to implement strict measures to slow the spread of the virus. The movement called "flatten the curve" prompted entertainment, bar and restaurant closures across the US and Canada. By Monday, all NBA, PGA, MLB, MLS, NASCAR, NHL, and NCAA sporting events were either canceled or put on hold for two or more weeks. Some especially hard hit areas, including seven counties in California, put a three-week-long "Shelter in Place" home restriction on citizens, requiring they leave their homes only for essential needs. Workers in essential services (emergency and medical, banks, grocery, pharmacy and food service) were exempted from the restriction, so they could work.

17 St. Patrick's Day Celebrations were canceled (even in Ireland). Nonessential services (cafes, movie theaters, shopping malls, etc.) were closed for 30+ days in many states. The Canadian US border was closed to travel (but not trade) in a mutual agreement.

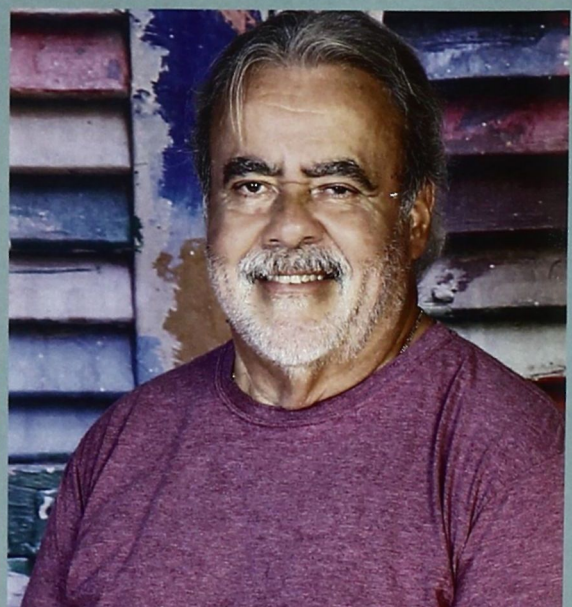
