Funds available for financing college

MILLIONS of dollars are available each year to help students who are planning to continue their education in college. The variety of educational institutions, public and private, that offer education to students are numerous. College students can apply for financial aid through the following sources: Veterans' Administration, Social Security, vocational rehabilitation and other programs of a similar nature that provide benefits to qualified students. A single phone call will usually produce the needed answers.

Both state and federal governments provide substantial amounts of funding through grants and guaranteed loans. Information about these financial aid programs are available through high school guidance offices and the college financial aid offices in each state.

Sometimes, parents can help their children obtain financial aid by applying for loans. Many banks provide needed loans. Financial aid offices provide information to better community colleges and vocational schools.

Some companies offer financial assistance to students or employees. Parents should check at their place of work for details of financial assistance available and how they can obtain it.

Other service organizations and civic clubs provide funds to help students obtain a scholarship to high school graduates. School guidance counselors can provide information about who and how to obtain the money.

Considerable importance is given to various college admissions' offices, early in the senior year, to determine exactly what financial aid is available. Objective consideration and choices can then be made.



Enjoy school

For many students attending school is not an enjoyable experience. Therefore, when school becomes compulsory, a logical approach would be to try to make it as pleasant as possible.

First, make a firm commitment to develop a positive attitude. Make sure you are living for class on time, being attentive, and doing your best outside of classroom assignments.

Second, try to make school more interesting. Try to become involved in a variety of activities, but not to the extent that they become overwhelming or consequently unpleasant.

At the year's beginning, plan what you would like to accomplish. And, most important, work toward those goals.

School doesn't have to be and usually isn't a burden. One of life's most important goals is to prove that school is pleasurable. It is dependent on a student's input and his attitude, and not his education.



