Funds available for financing college

BILLIONS of dollars are available each year to help students who are planning to enter college. This money is available from a wide variety of sources, including public and private.

For example, a student who is a member of the National Honor Society may be eligible for a scholarship. Similarly, a student who is a member of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration may be eligible for a scholarship.

Some students may also be eligible for a scholarship based on their academic achievement. For example, a student who is a member of the National Honor Society may be eligible for a scholarship.

Parents should check at their place of work to determine if their employer offers a scholarship program. If so, they should check with the employer to learn more about the program.

Of considerable importance is to write to various college admission offices early in the senior year to determine exactly what financial aid is available. Objective comparisons and choices can then be made.

Don't forget to consider the Veterans' Administration, Social Security, vocational rehabilitation and other programs of a similar nature that provide benefits to qualified students. A single phone call will usually produce the needed answers.

Both state and federal governments provide substantial amounts of funding through grants and guaranteed loans. Information about these financial aid programs are available through high school guidance offices and libraries.

In addition, colleges offer aid in various ways. Some provide benefits of full or partial scholarships. These may be based on academic or athletic performance or strictly on a student's need. Usually, colleges also have a work program to help students financially.

Of considerable importance is to write to various college admission offices early in the senior year to determine exactly what financial aid is available. Objective comparisons and choices can then be made.

Enjoy school

For many students, attending school is not an enjoyable activity. Therefore, your local education is compulsory. A logical approach would be to try and make it as pleasant as possible.

First, make a firm commitment to develop a positive relationship with your teachers. This means arriving for class on time, being attentive, and doing your best on outside or in-class assignments.

Second, find ways to make your school more enjoyable. Try to become involved in a variety of activities, but not to the extent that they become overwhelming and cause you to miss out on other things.

As the year goes by, plan ahead. Set definite goals that you would like to accomplish. And most important, work toward these goals.

School doesn't have to be and usually isn't a boring time of life for most students. However, the extent that school is pleasant is dependent on a student's input and his attitude, and not just on education.



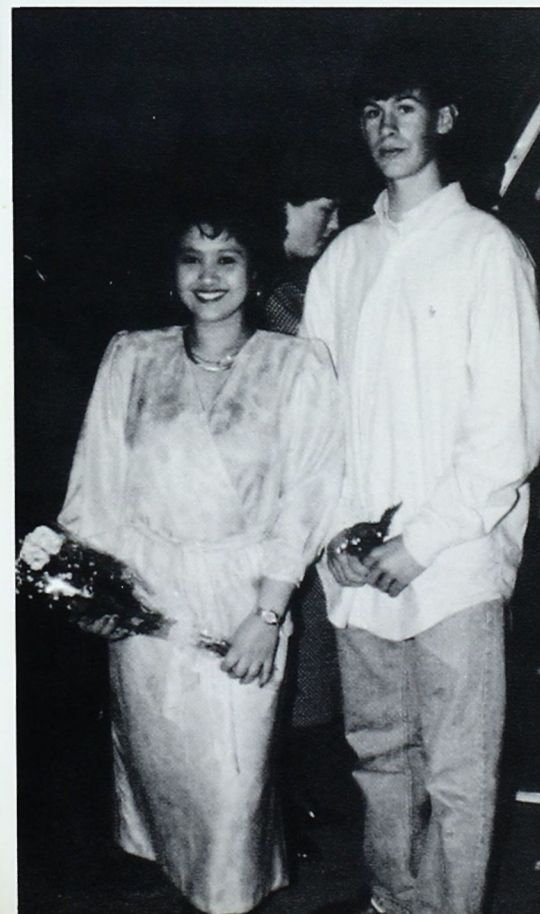
