EAGLES ROMP TO

The 1967 Frankfurt Eagles football team started the season with two new coaches and only a handful of returning players. They finished the season with a 6-1 record, winning the first undisputed conference championship for Frankfurt in many years. It was a season that saw the Eagles beat the Wiesbaden Warriors, their arch-rivals, twice.

The Frankfurt Eagles opened the 1967 season by playing the Ludwigsburg Stallions at Ludwigsburg. The Stallions swung into action immediately, rolling up a 20-0 lead in the first half. Quarterback Bernie Smith connected with flanker Dan Robinson on a 48 yard touchdown bomb. Smith then plunged for the conversion points. At the end of play the score stood Frankfurt 8--Ludwigsburg 26.

On the following Saturday the Eagles played the Wiesbaden Warriors in their first conference game. The first half was scoreless until the hard--changing Eagle defense spearheaded by Steve Chapman blocked a Warrior punt and recovered on the Wiesbaden one. On the ensuing play Bernie Smith sliced through the Warrior line for six points. On the first play of the second half, halfback Mike Nicholson stunned the Warriors by taking the opening kick-off and racing 85 yards for another Eagle score. The Warriors could manage only

one score against an Eagle defense that stopped them six times inside the Eagle ten yard line. The final whistle sounded with the score Frankfurt 12--Wiesbaden 6.

The Eagles next hosted the Kaiserslautern Raiders at home. Firmly in control all the way, Frankfurt led from the first quarter. After forcing the Raiders to punt, the Eagles took the ball on their own 49. On the sixth play Bernie Smith romped ten yards for the touchdown. In the second quarter Smith found his favorite receiver, Dan Robinson, in the open and connected for a 25 yard score. The Eagles culminated the scoring in the third quarter when the defense forced the Raiders into a punting situation on the Raider 4. Fullback Ron Gilven took the punt and sprinted 30 yards for a TD.

Once more the Eagle defense outdid itself, allowing the Raiders a net total of 0 yards rushing. The final score stood Frankfurt 18--Kaiserslautern 0.

The Eagles again hit the road to meet the London Bobcats on a rain-soaked London field. In the first quarter the Frankfurt defense forced a Bobcat fumble and recovered on the London 15. Three plays later halfback Jim Blanks scored on an 8 yard ramble. In the second quarter Blanks took a pass from Bernie Smith and powered 16 yards for a touchdown. End Steve Bari kicked the extra point after each of these scores. In the fourth quarter Bernie Smith connected with Dan Robinson for a 70 yard strike. Smith hit end Harry Grindrod for the conversion points. The Eagles wound up their scoring when halfback Mike Nicholson gathered in a pass from Bernie Smith and outran Bobcat defenders to the goal. The game ended with the score Frankfurt 28--London 8.



BLUE DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP



In Frankfurt's Homecoming game the Eagles played the Wiesbaden Warriors in a showdown match. The Eagles drew first blood as Bernie Smith capped a 52 yard drive by scrambling 27 yards for a TD. Steve Bari booted the ball through the goalposts for the extra point. Frankfurt struck again in the second quarter when Dan Robinson pulled in a Smith pass and raced into the endzone. Again,

Steve Bari kicked the extra point. The Warriors retaliated with a short pass that went for an 80 yard touchdown. After a colorful halftime show the two teams once more came to grips. This time it was a battle of defense, and Frankfurt proved equal to the task. The Warriors reached the Eagle three, but there they stayed. Wiesbaden's quarterback faded back and tossed a pass into the endzone, but Mike Nicholson leaped high in the air to intercept and nail the lid on the Warrior coffin. The final was Frankfurt 14--Wiesbaden 8. By defeating the Warriors, the Eagles clinched the Blue Division crown.

Frankfurt traveled to Kaiserslautern to wind up the conference season. On the Eagles' third play from scrimmage, Bernie Smith swept through the Raider defense for a TD. Later on in the first quarter Smith took the Eagles from their own 33 to another score in seven plays, ending with a 37 yard pass to Steve Bari. Harry Grinrod pulled in a third-quarter Smith pass from five yards out and plunged over. Halfback Bob Taylor opened the fourth quarter with a 9 yard sweep around end for six points. Benny Holden booted the extra point. Steve Bari converted for the other three scores. Against the rough Eagle defense the Raiders were close to a score only once. In the fourth quarter they reached the Frankfurt 2 but went no further. Final score, Frankfurt 28--Kaiserslautern 0.

In the final game of the season the Eagles hosted the Lakenheath Lancers. On the first play from scrimmage the Frankfurt defense forced a Lancer fumble and recovered. On the next play Bernie Smith faded back and laid the ball right in the arms of Dan Robinson for a 32 yard score. Later in the same quarter Smith found his end, Harry Grindrod, in the open and connected for a 28 yard TD. Steve Bari kicked the extra point. Then, the game remained scoreless until the fourth quarter. Smith took the Eagles from the Lancer 47 and scored on a 1 yard dive. Jim Blanks cracked across for the extra point. The Lancers scored once on a 56 yard play. The final: Frankfurt 21--Lakenheath 8.



The Eagle offense, led by quarterback Bernie Smith, halfback Jim Blanks, and halfback Mike Nicholson, succeeded in keeping their opponents off balance all through the season. The high-powered offense had a combined passing and rushing average of 308 yards per game. Rushing took the greater share of this with a 171 yard average, while the passing game averaged 137 yards per game. On the rushing scene, halfback Jim Blanks was the leading gainer, with 335 yards for a 4.6 yard average. Following were Mike Nicholson, 321 yards and a 4.5 yard average; Bernie Smith, 272 yards for a 3.1 yard average; and Bob Taylor, 96 yards and a 4.6 yard average. In the air, Bernie Smith took all the honors with 43 completions in 96 attempts for a .448 average, 835 yards, and ten touchdowns. Dan Robinson led in latching on to Smith's passes, making 13 catches for 371 yards and five scores. He was followed by Harry Grindrod, 14 receptions, 172 yards, and two touchdowns; Russell Sturgeon, 4 catches for 65 yards; Steve Bari, 5 catches for 89 yards and one touchdown; and Mike Nicholson, 4 receptions for 121 yards and one score. Smith led the scoring with 32 points, followed by Dan Robinson, 30, Harry Grindrod, 14, Steve Bari, 14, Mike Nicholson, 12, Jim Blanks, 12, Ron Gilven, 6, Bob Taylor, 6, and Benny Holden 1.

The defensive squad, considered by many to be the best in Germany, was a highlight throughout the season. In contrast to the Eagles' 308 yard average, Frankfurt's opponents were allowed only 147 per game, less than half. The stingy defense allowed only 4.66 points per game. The opposition was able to get inside the Eagle ten yard line eight times, but could score only once.

The 1967 season was capped by having many of the Eagles chosen to the all-conference team. Along with Bernie Smith on the offensive team were Harry Grindrod, Steve Chapman, Mike Jernigan, Dan Robinson, and Mike Nicholson. Grindrod and Jernigan were also chosen to the defensive team, with Carl Fields, Bill House, Skip Douglas, and Don ayers.

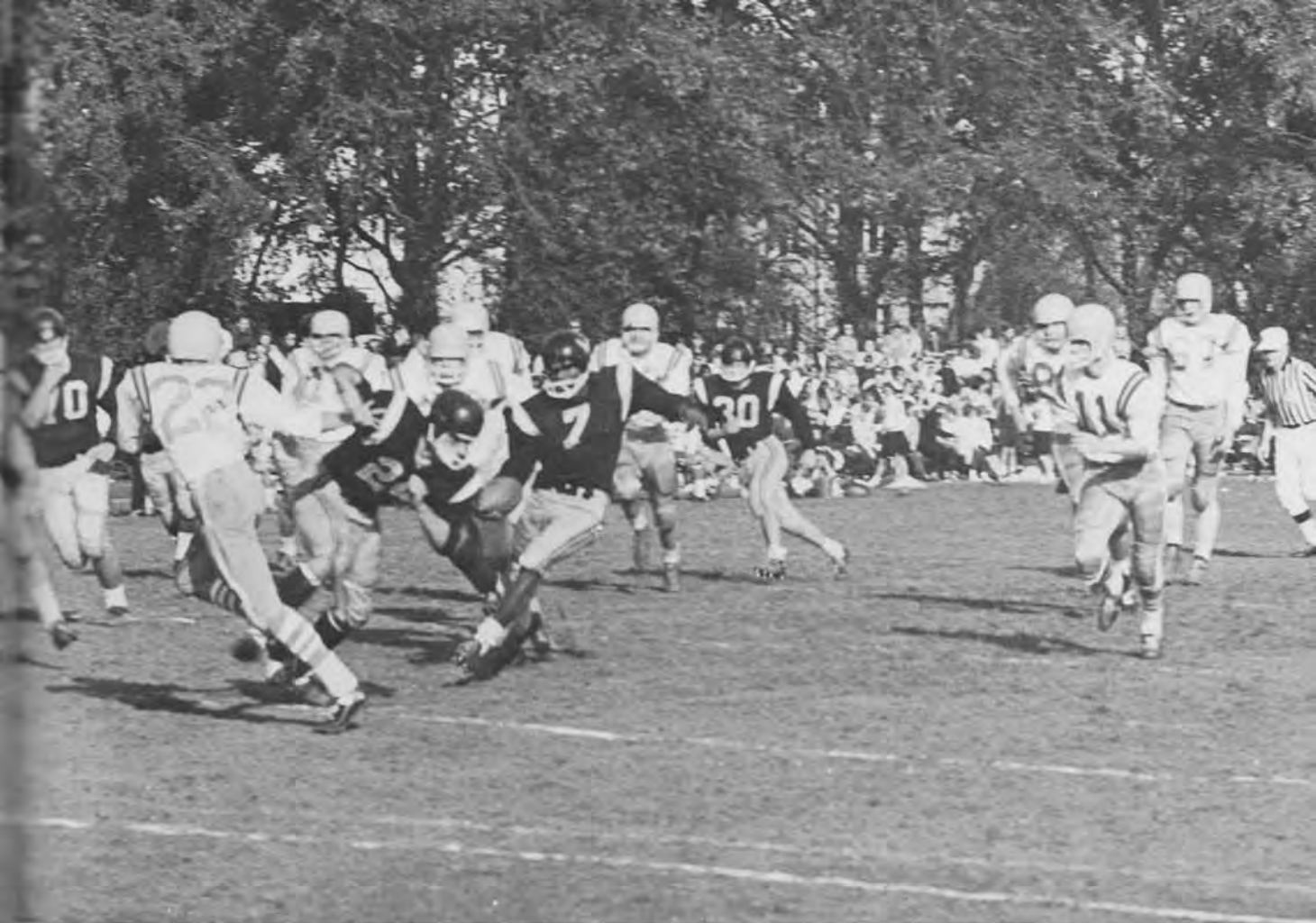

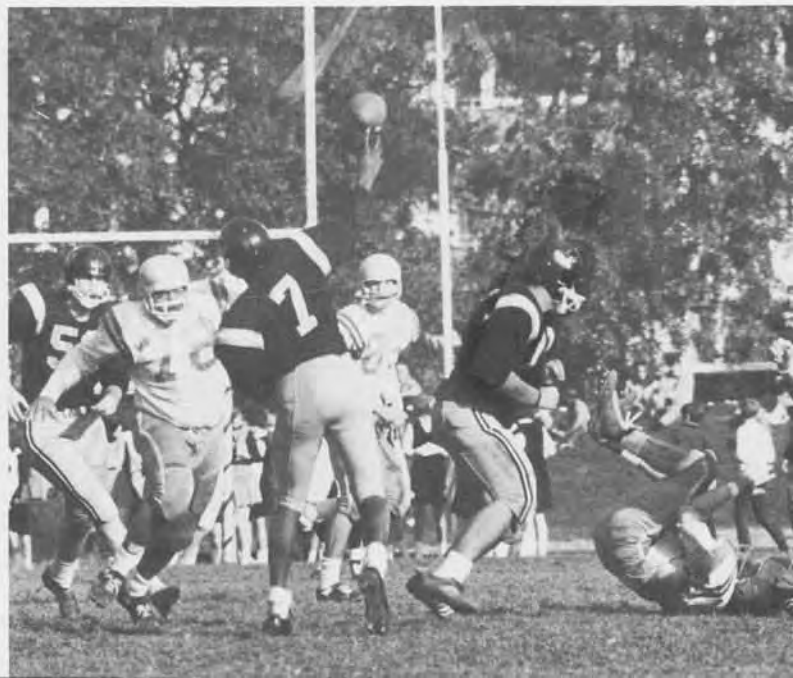

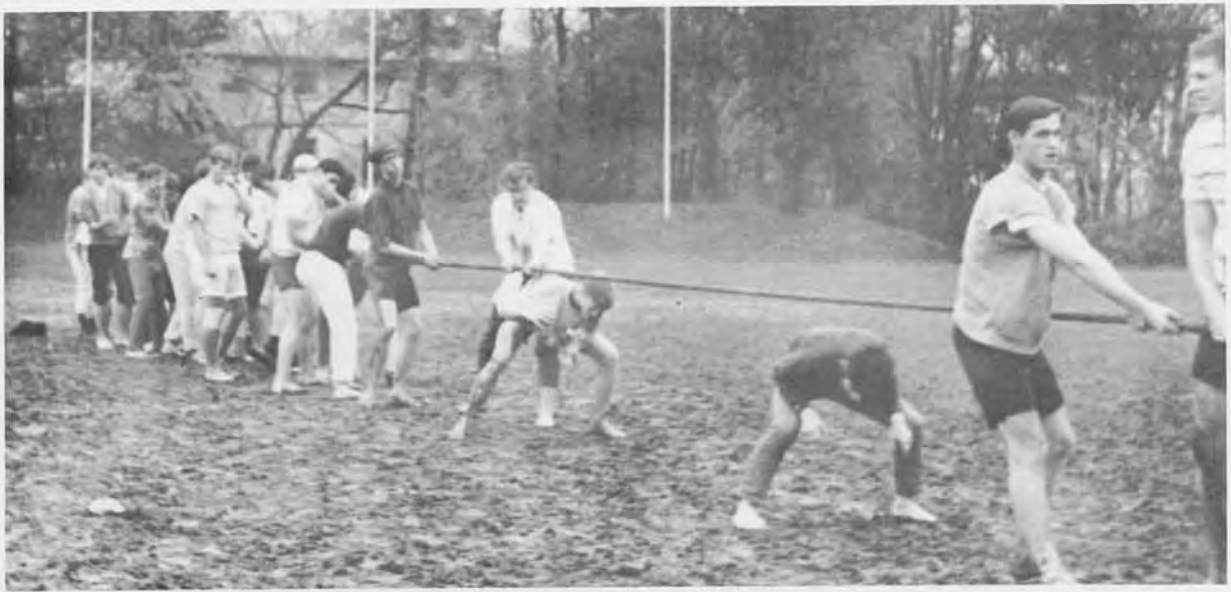
