Or accenting it?

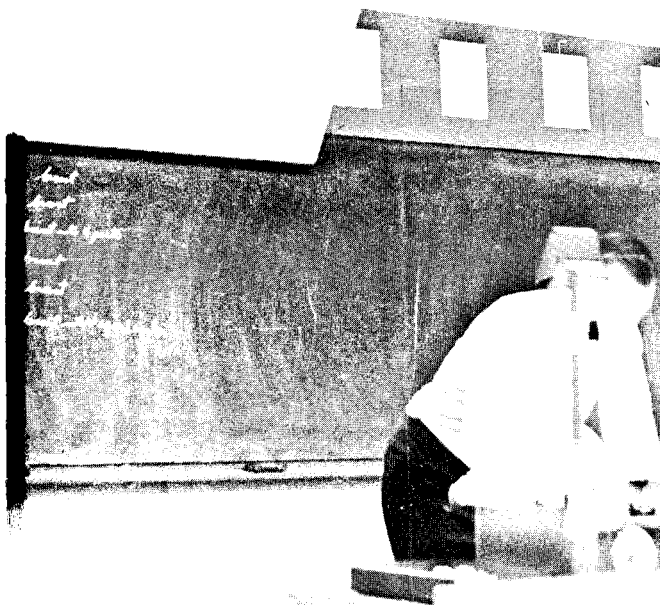

## CHESS

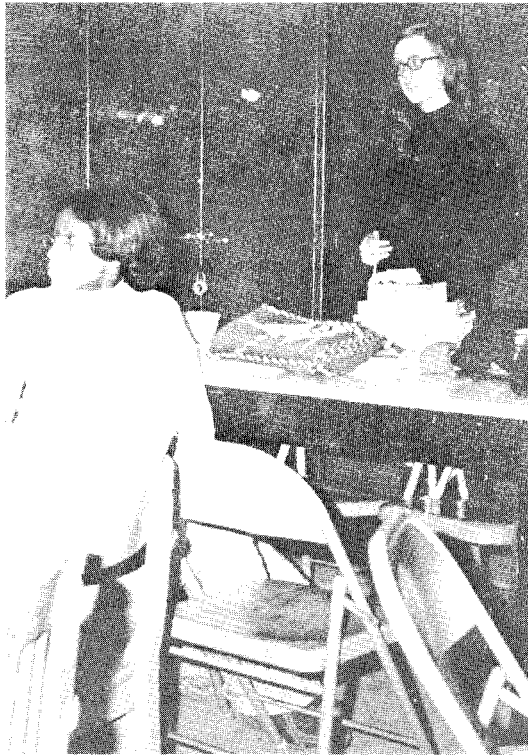

We will realize what we learned in school is not just math and science, English and P.E., but the ways of life and of living with the others around us. And again, we will remember the trickle of water from the fountains, the animals in the zoo, the Saturdays in the park, skip-days, nights in Moningers, the concerts at the Festplatz, the castle and its lake. . .

All these memories are ours to keep as long as the heart is willing and the mind is able. For those are life-long reflections in the pool of time.
