Karlsruhe was 2-2 in the conference, Ulm was 3-1. It was a muddy, rainy game. The score was 0-0 after one quarter of play. Ulm went back to punt, after Karlsruhe had stopped them in three straight downs. The ball was snapped, but Eddie Twohill broke through the line to block the punt. Don Page caught the blocked punt and ran 33 yards for a touchdown. The next score for Karlsruhe came from combinations of Mike Allen to Zack Lewis and Mike Allen to Tommy Shank. The final run for the score was an eight yard dash by Zack Lewis. The final score was Karlsruhe 12, Ulm 7. The Knights' season got off to a rough start, but as evidenced by the last game, they never gave up.





Victory

The Karlsruhe Knights started the season by losing a key player who could have made the difference in the team's overall record. The Knights did not let the loss stop them from playing rough football. The spirit and determination displayed by the Knights gained them respect throughout the conference. The Knights began the season with three straight losses: to Augsburg, to Vilseck, and to Bad Kreuznach. The Knights then caught fire with their first victory over Soesterberg. The next game was against the conference leader, Bonn. The Knights played the Crusaders to a 6-6 regulation final. Seven Kansas City Tie-Breakers had to be played out to decide the winner: Bonn. After the Bonn game, the Knights would lose no more as they went on to defeat Brussels and Ulm.
