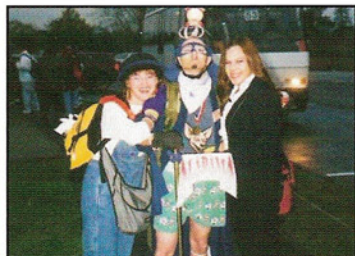
# Come As You Are Spirit Week

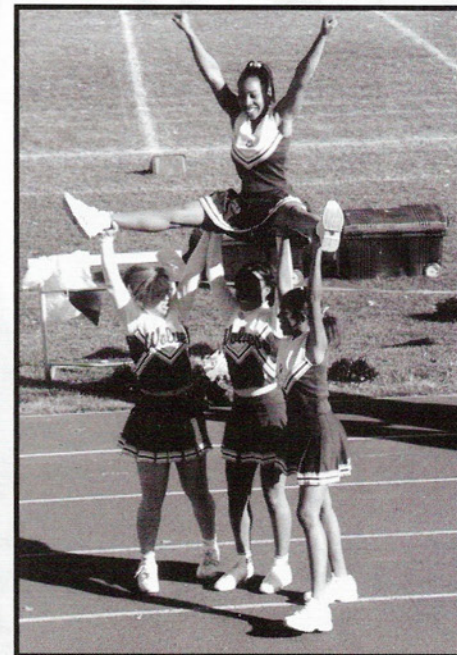

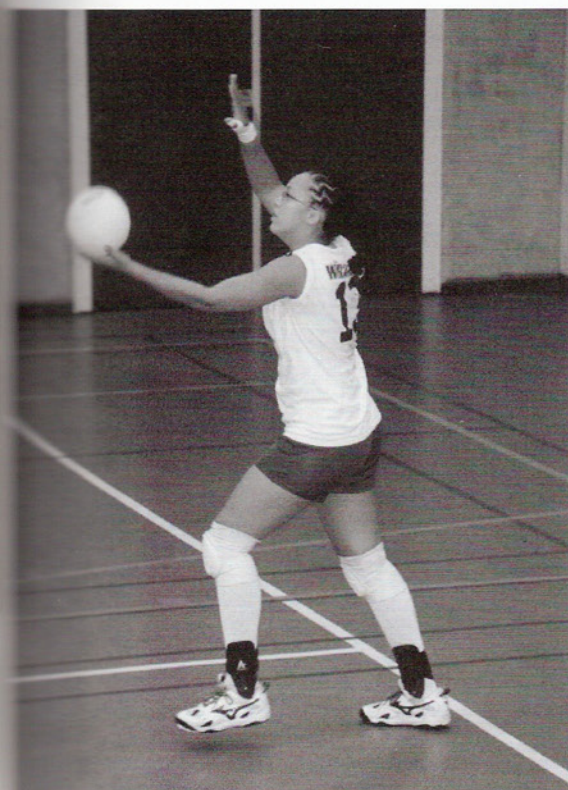

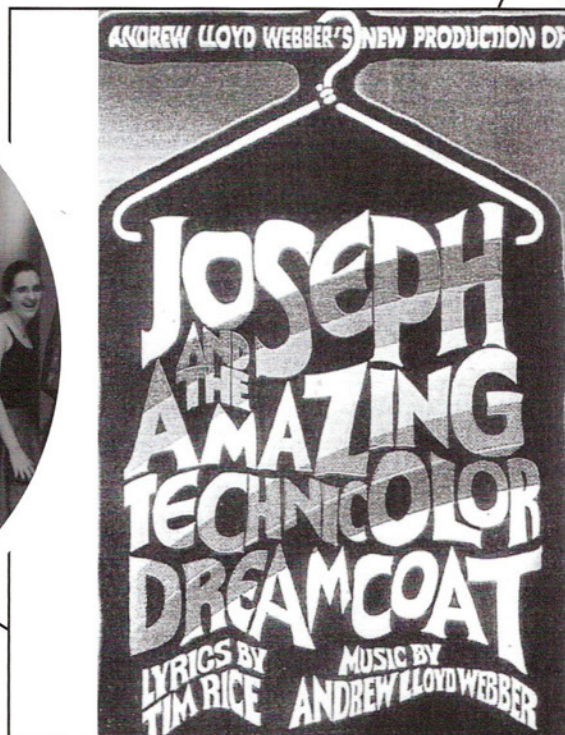
# Joseph

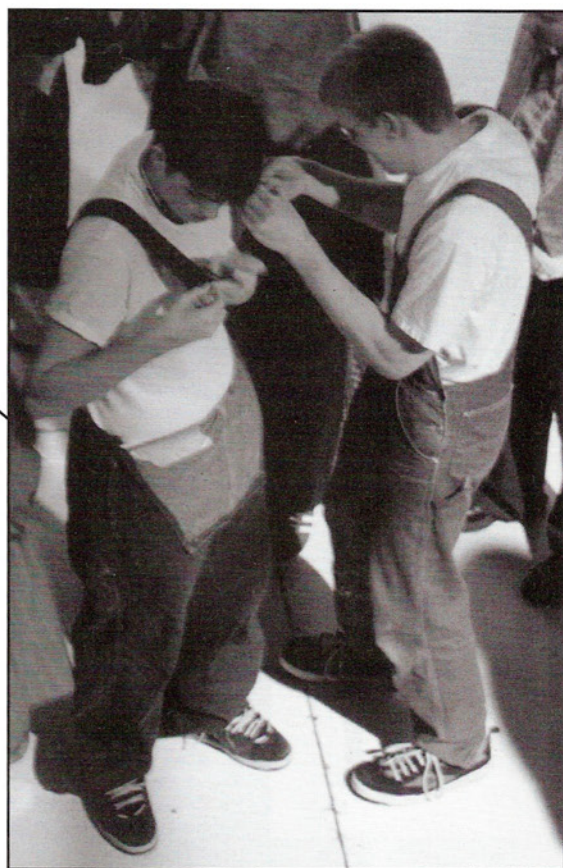

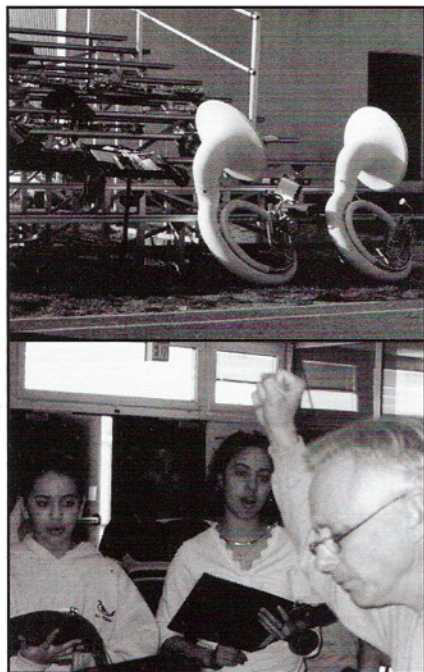

Our students started to prepare for this conference in the beginning of the year. The MUN students split into six committees and various commissions.

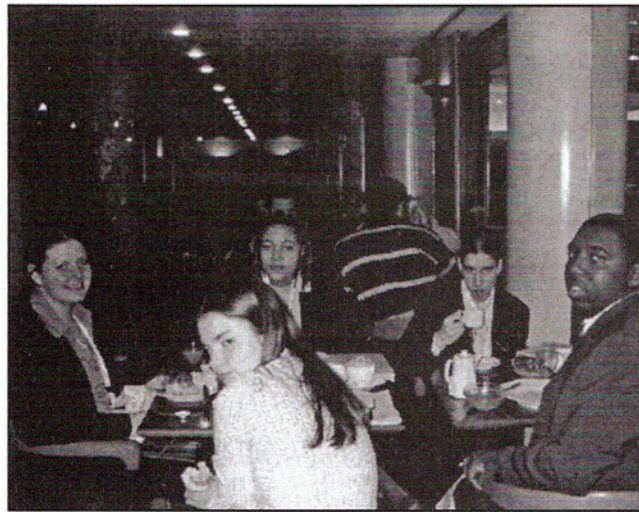

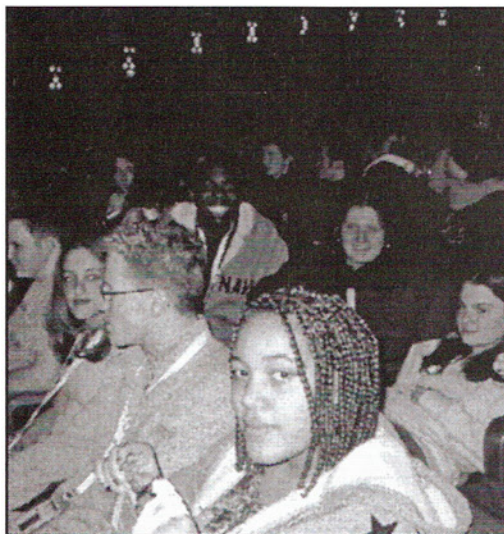

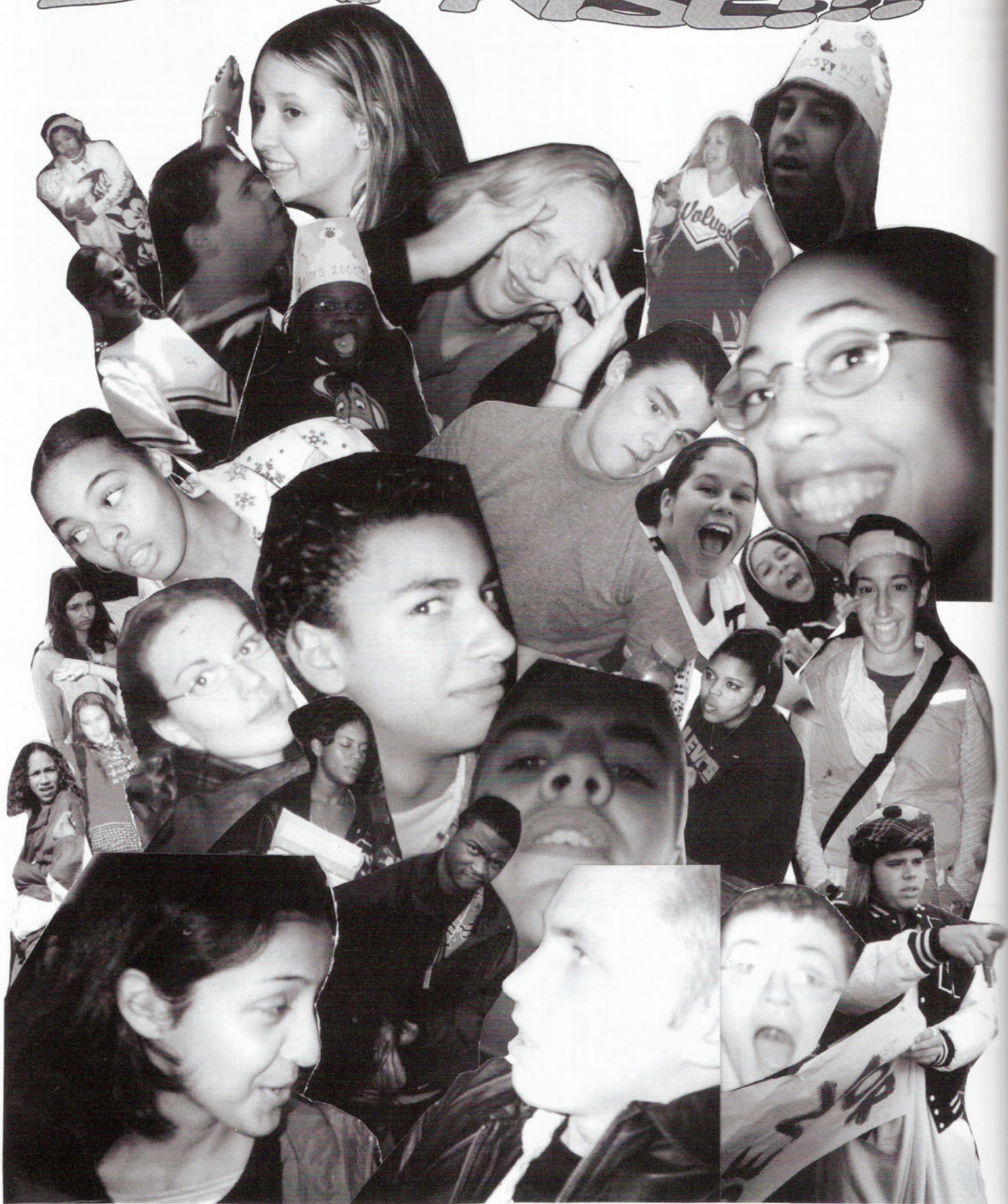
