

3,500 Youths To Answer ET School Bells

The Stars and Stripes Bureau *(see below) FRANKFURT, Sept. 20, 1946

According to latest estimates of the Theater Dependents' Education office, about 500 high school and 3,000 grammar and kindergarten children will answer roll call when American schools in Germany open their doors about two weeks from now.

...He added that theater school policy calls for elementary schools to be set up in every community which has ten or more students.

There'll be no truant officers...for attendance is not compulsory. High school students are expected to attend the nearest one of six centrally located American high schools, commuting by community-arranged transportation...or boarding if necessary.

The six schools...are Berlin-60 students, Bremen-35, Frankfurt-163, Heidelberg-75, Munich-74, Erlangen (Amberg, Ansbach, Bad Kissingen, Bamberg, Bayreuth, Gibelstadt (sic), Grafenwohr, Kitzingen, Regensburg, Schweinfurt, Straubing, Wieden, Wurzburg, and Nurnberg-115.

HISTORY OF WÜRZBURG HIGH SCHOOL

Würzburg American High School officially began with the 1954-1955 school year in Building #1, the present Headquarters Building located right inside the front gate. Prior to this time, students in grades 9-12 went to high school in Nürnburg (Erlangen) where they stayed in the dormitories during the week.



Students were bussed from Wertheim, Kitzingen, Schweinfurt and Bad Kissingen. In 1970, with the advent of a north Autobahn, the students from Wildflecken began to attend our school. They had previously been dorm students in Frankfurt.


During the school year 1975-76, the new additon (over 50%) included a Cosmotology Lab, Business Lab, Auto Shop, Cafetorium, gymnastics room and regular classrooms.

In January 1987, a new annex was completed which included a home economics lab, art room, electronics lab, teacher workroom, science labs and a new media center. (D Hall).


A new administration wing was finished Aug.28, 1989 making it possible for all administrators and clerical staff to be together in the front of the school.

Students in grades 5-8 were relocated to the middle school upon its completion in August of 1990, making Wuerzburg American High School truly a high school with only grades 9-12. In 1949 the first multi-school annual was published for DoDDE, called "Frinnerungen" (Memories). In 1955, Würzburg was added to the annual. In 1961, each school began to produce their own yearbook, Würzburg's named "The Ambassador." In 2008, we finished the final Würzburg yearbook.
