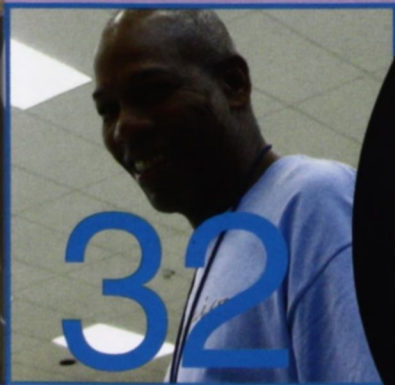

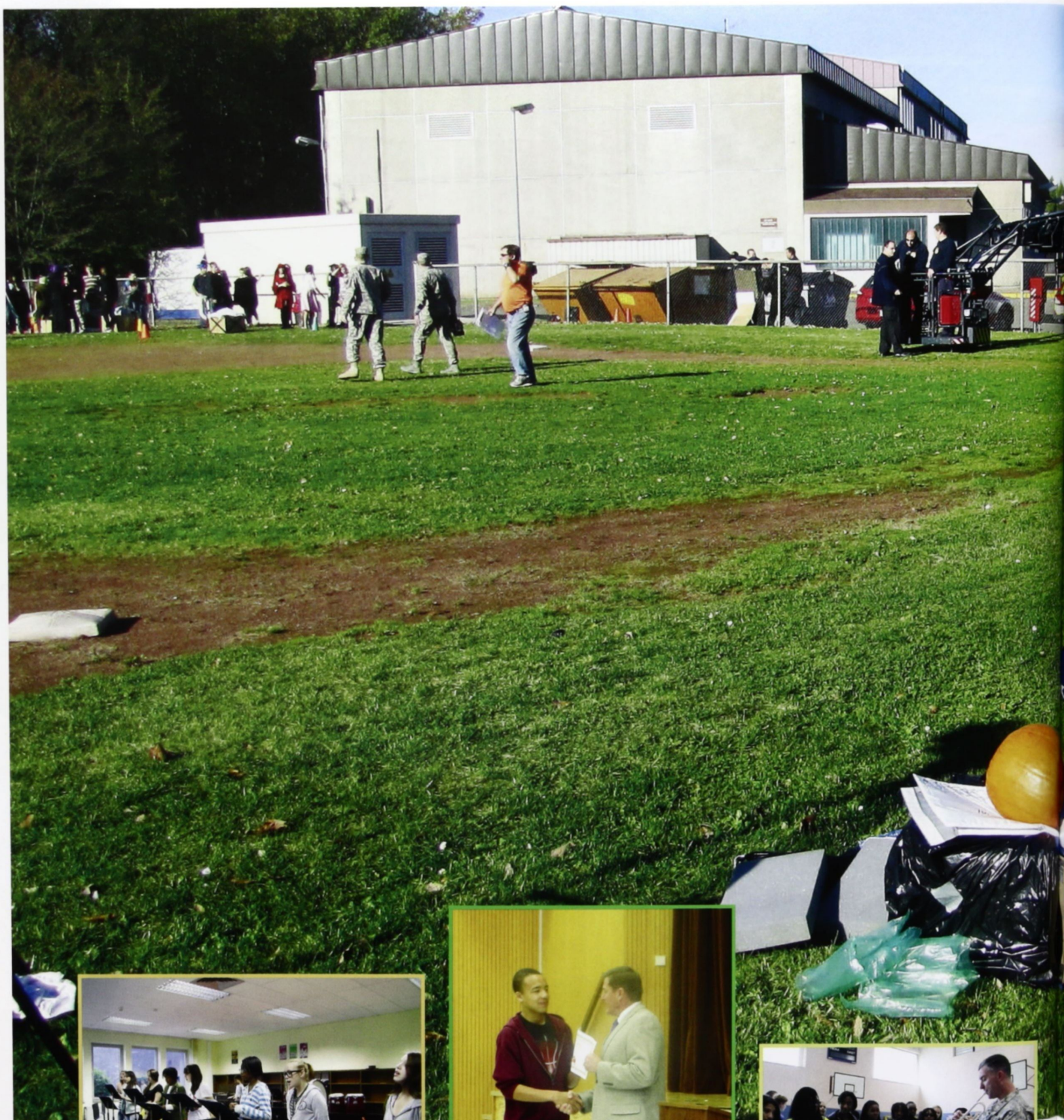

Students who earn excellent grades are honored at quarterly honor roll assemblies.



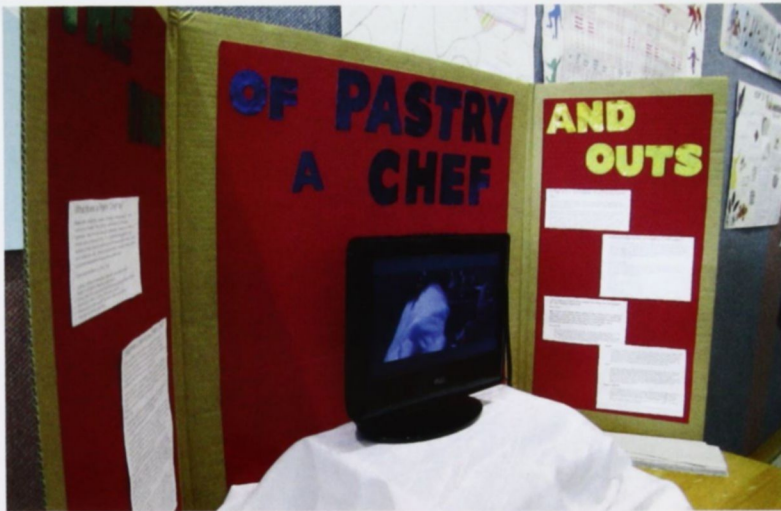

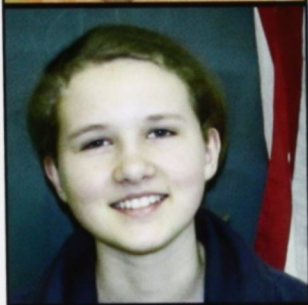
How we play
