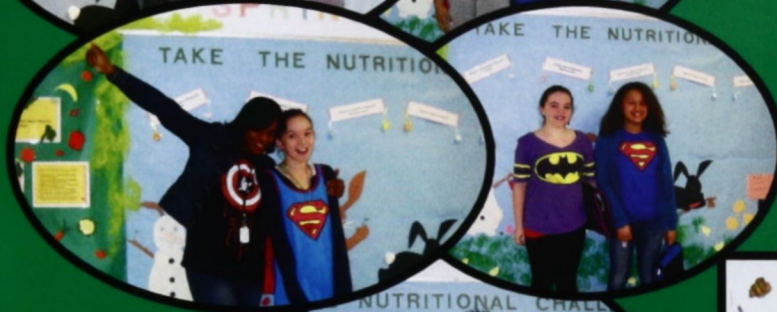
School Field Trip to Worms



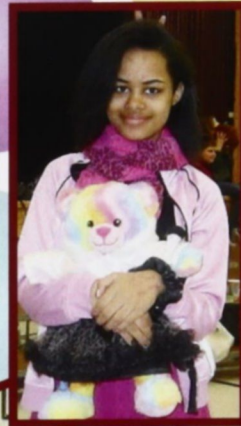
