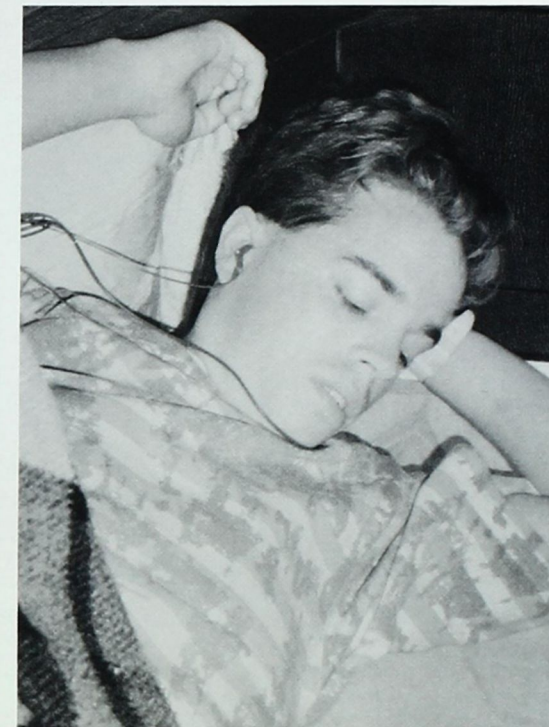
Upon arrival to the destination the so called athletes, now feeling like a group of dead zombies, are given a cold floor to sleep on and don't forget the COLD shower!!
