As representatives of the student body the members of the Student Council exemplified democracy in action at its best.

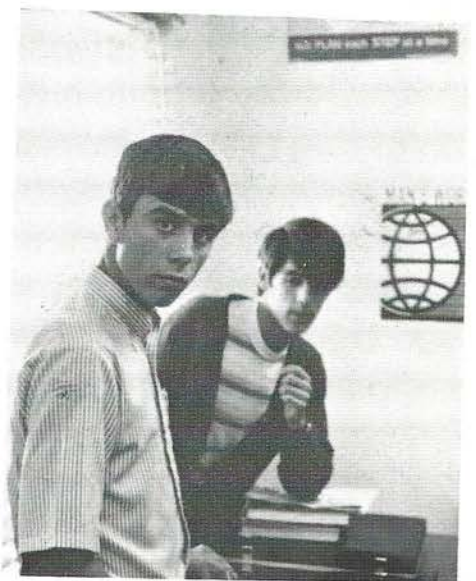
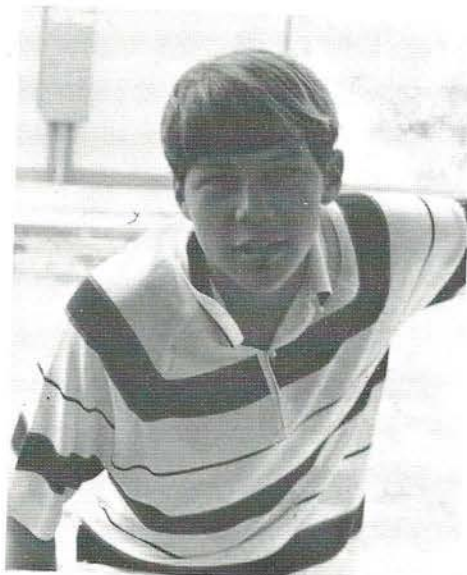
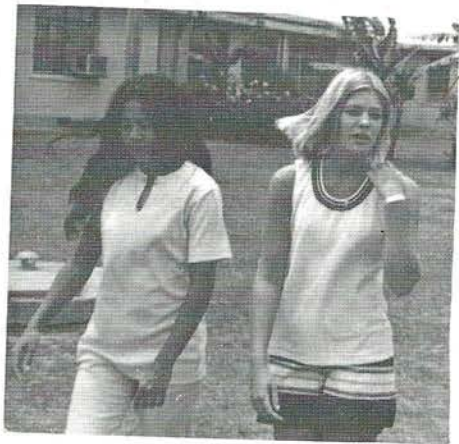
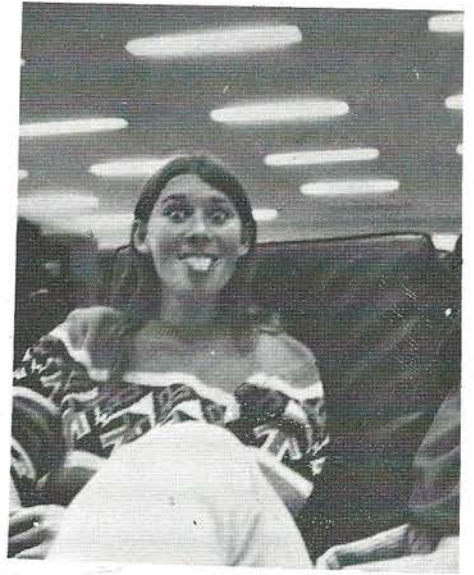
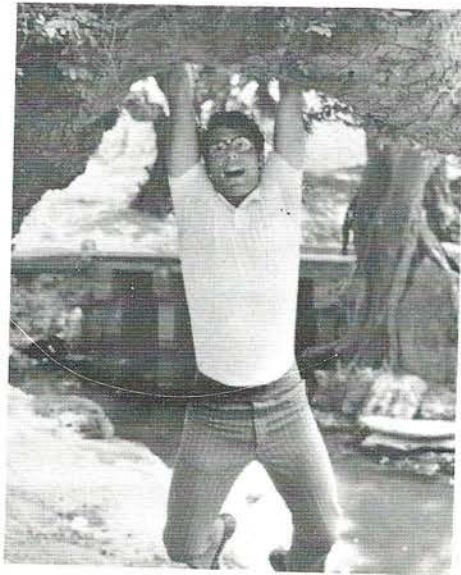
