Julie Love: "Oma." I like to call my Grandmother.



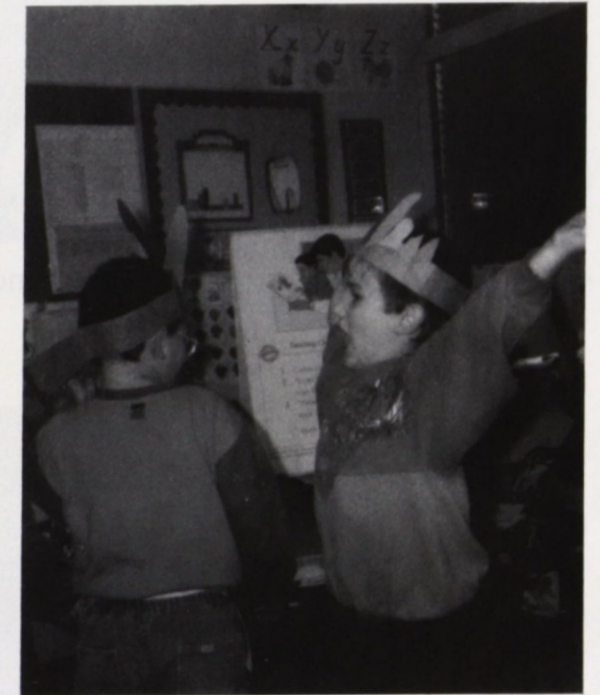
