SPORTS 1969-70



THE HADITE FOOTBALL SEASON

The Hadites began this year with a young and inexperienced team. With only four returning lettermen, Coach Nash had to face the trials of a rebuilding year. However, with the aid of Mr. Carr, the line coach, the Hadites managed to come up with a team which could hold its own against the UK competition.

The Hadites went into the first game against Shape half crippled with the suspension of seven of their starters. On the opening play from scrimmage, Shape's quarterback, Keith Koposta, scampered around the right end for a 55 yard touchdown. Then, midway through the first quarter, the Hadites lost Don Virostko when he tore the ligament in his knee, an injury which would hurt the Hadites the rest of the year. From then on the Hadites were completely out of the game. Koposta ran another 30 yard touchdown the second quarter out of the game. Koposta ran another 30 year touchdown the second quarter and threw another in the fourth. The Hadites lost their opening game 21-0.

With the return of the seven, the Hadites went into the second game against London with high hopes. The Hadites' first drive was halted on the London 20 yard line but managed to score on their second drive when Bob Seliquini scored from the four. The defense for the rest of the half and the Hadites led at half-time 6-0. With the start of the second half the Bobcats scored two quick touchdowns. In the fourth quarter they found a hole in the Hadite secondary and went on to score two more TDs via the air. Final score -- London 28, Heyford 6.

The Hadites then travelled to Lakenheath to meet the Lancers as four point favorite. The Hadites, now plagued with injuries and four starters out, including Don Virostko who had to watch the game from his hospital window, never got started. The Lakenheath defense limited Heyford yardage while their offense managed to score 3 times with a series of single, double and triple reverses. The Hadites went home once again with a defeat — this time 20-0.

The Hadites met the London Bobcats again for their fourth game -- this time at home. Like the first game, the Hadites scored early with Paul Newman plunged over from the 2 yard line. The London offence came righ back six plays later to score, making it Heyford 6, London 6. Then, with a few seconds left, the Hadites went to the air to try and score before the half. Their hopes were shattered when a Bobcat defensive back picked off a pass on his own ten and ran unmolested 90 yards for a touchdown. At the half it was London 12, Heyford 6. The second half saw grim, tough football with the Hadites controlling the ball most of the time. However, the Bobcats managed to score once more -- making the final score London 20, Heyford 6.

The fifth game was Heyford's Homecoming against Lakenheath. The Hadites got off to an early start, scoring when Dennis Garner went off tackle from the 4 yard line. The Lancers came back one in the first half to score, making it 6-6. The second half saw both defenses firm, each team failing to score. Then, on a block kick, the Lancers rumbled into the end zone and the final score, Lakenheath 14, Heyford 6.


For their sixth game Heyford traveled to Brussels, determined to win one. Although 4-point underdogs, the Hadites had little trouble with the surprised Brigands. The Hadites scored twice in the first half with a 1 yard plunge from QB George Kunberger and a 4-yard drive from Paul Newman. In the second quarter, the Hadites lost control of the ball twice inside the Brussels 10 yard line. Then with 40 seconds left in the first half, and on the 50 yard line, the Hadites went to the air. Two short wing passes to Dennis Garner and a 30 yard pass to Ren Goff placed the Hadites on the Brussels 4 yard line, where Paul Newman again carried it over. Half time score—Heyford 20, Brussels 0. The Hadites scored again early in the third period on a 37 yd. TD pass. Near the end of the third quarter halfback Jerry Eaton, picked off a brussels' pass and went 40 yards for the Hadites fifth touchdown. The Hadites scored once more on a 40 yard TD pass from Ren Goff to Paul Weicuss.

Despite the numerous TDs, the highlight of the game cane when the Hadites sent a 22-man defensive team on the field -- needless to say, they got the Brussels QB.

The final score was Heyford 42, Brussels 6. This victory ended the 1969-70 football season.




