Beginners Band Encouraged New Talent

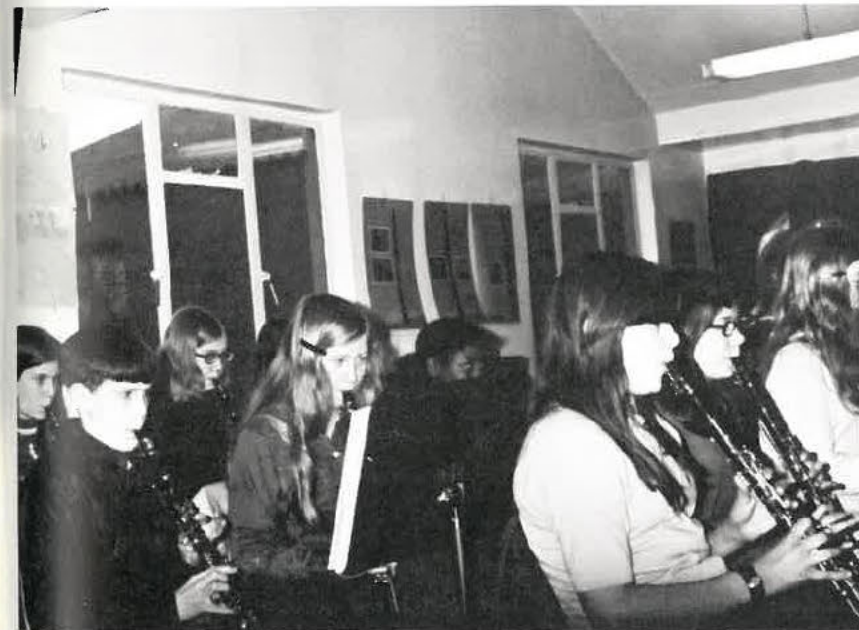

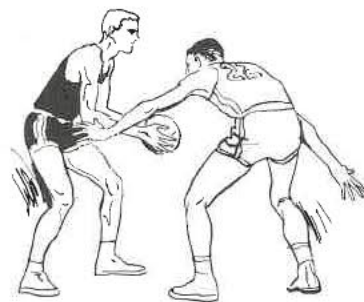

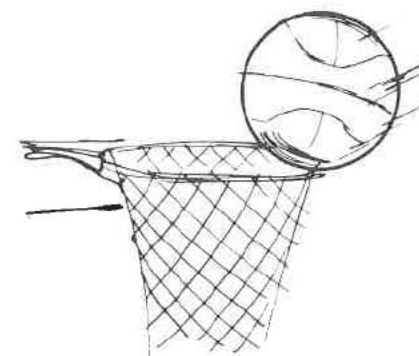
