Coach Drakulich did a fine job of leading the Cougars to the title after his third year as coach at Vicenza and is looking forward to a successful season next year!





The highlight of the year for the Band and Chorus was the Festival Musicale Italo-Americano held in Naples November 26 to December 2.


After a week of intensive 8 hour practice sessions, the group sang and played a series of pieces culminating in the Hallelujah Chorus from Handel's Messiah.


Homecoming

. . . Homecoming!


The word has a certain magic to it. It's an exciting time. The biggest football game is played, the dance of the year, next to the Prom is held.
