### Wiesbaden (50° 03'N, 8° 09'E): more than just a point on the globe?


This is the city where we've lived, studied, matured. But it has a history and a life of its own, beyond the American enclave of high school, housing, and Hainerberg. The area was inhabited by the Mattiaci, who were friendly towards their Roman conquerers of 58 B.C. and so allowed their territory to be transformed into a Roman resort. 
