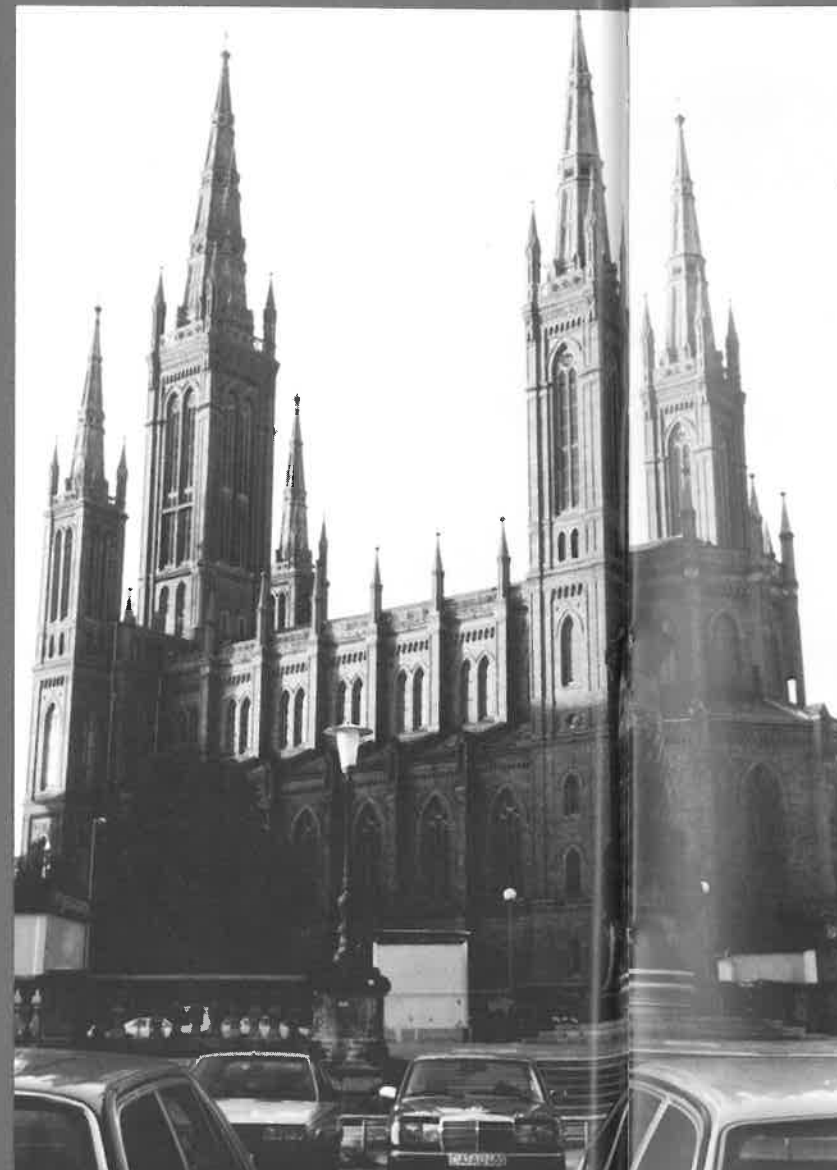
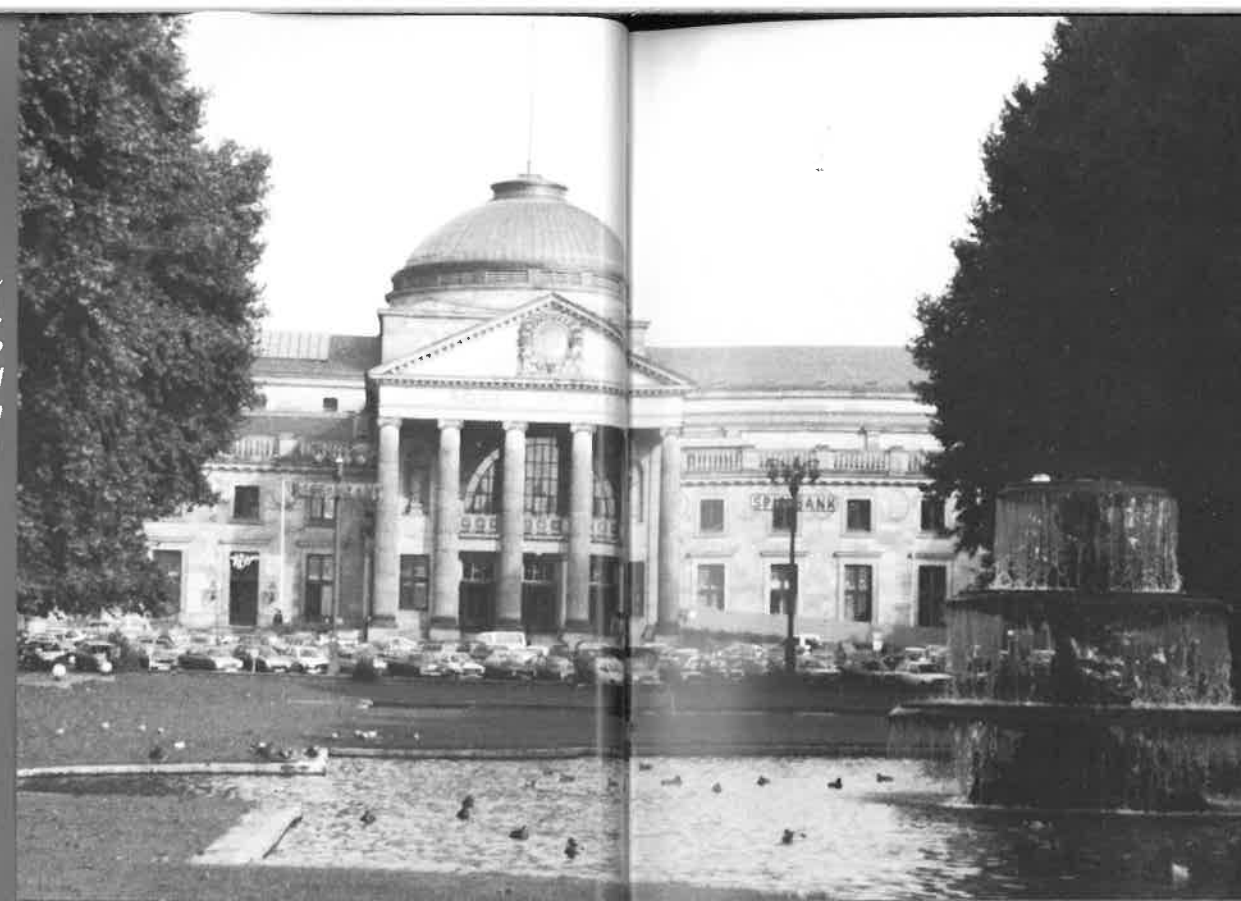

**W**iesbaden (50° 03'N, 8° 09'E): more than just a point on the globe?

*This is the city where we've lived, studied, matured. But it has a history and a life of its own, beyond the American enclave of high school, housing, and Hainerberg. The area was inhabited by the Mattiaci, who were friendly towards their Roman conquerors of 58 B.C. and so allowed their territory to be transformed into a Roman resort. That "Palm Springs" of ancient times is now Wiesbaden, the state capital of Hessen.*



Above center, we have the Wiesbaden Kurhaus, where people go to gamble and dine. Top left is the Russian "Golden Dome" church receiving a blessing from Kallie Pack. Bottom left is the Staats theater, where operas are performed, and most Gen H.H. Arnold seniors graduate. At the bottom center we have the Gothic style church, situated downtown near the walkplatz. Below right is Wiesbaden's Bahnhof, where trains connect the city to other European metropolitan areas. On the far right is a statue of Friedrich Wilhelm II. Notice the Hellenistic features of the face. Accompanying the statue in the Kurpark is an impressionistic sculpture by France Rotar.

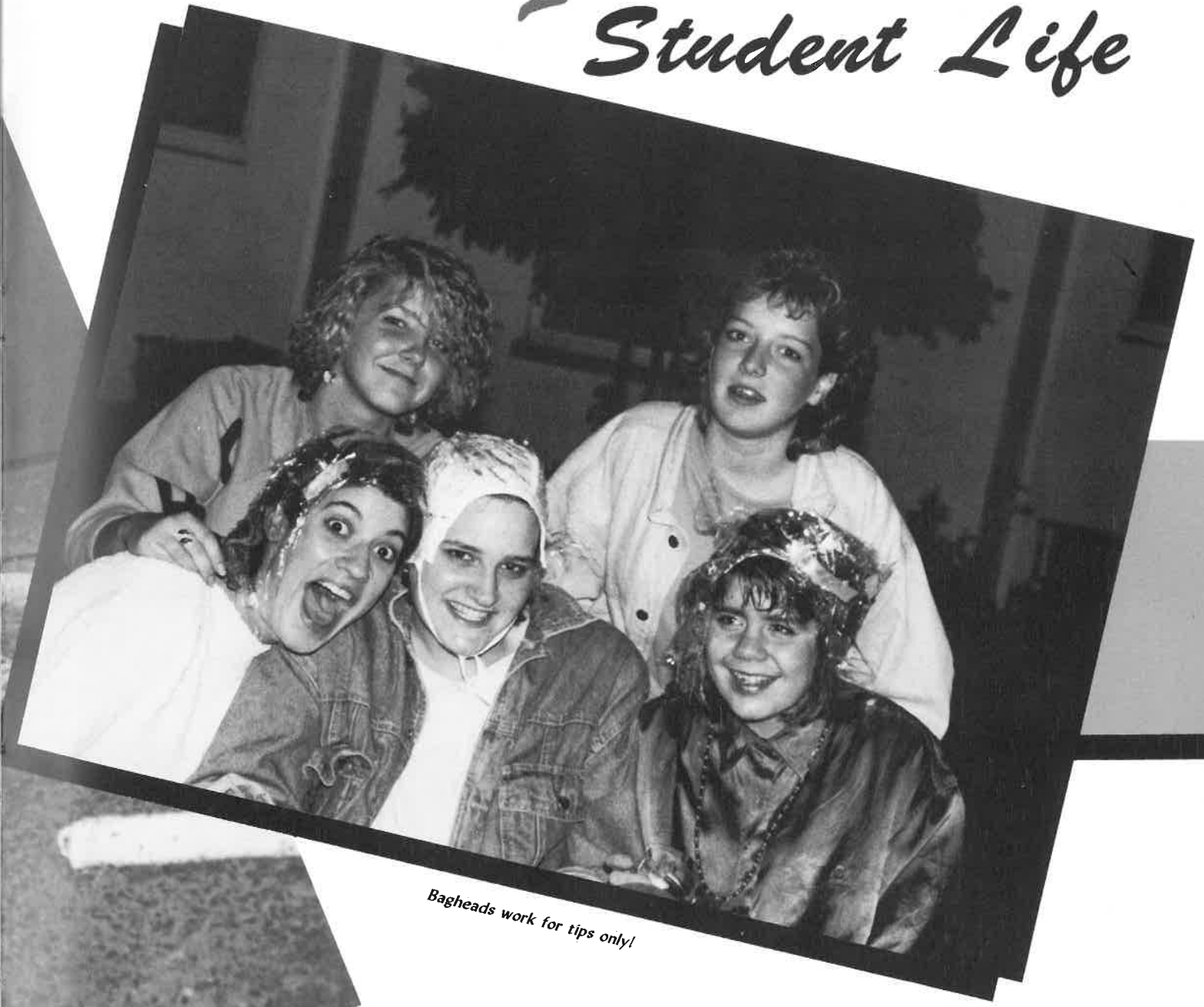

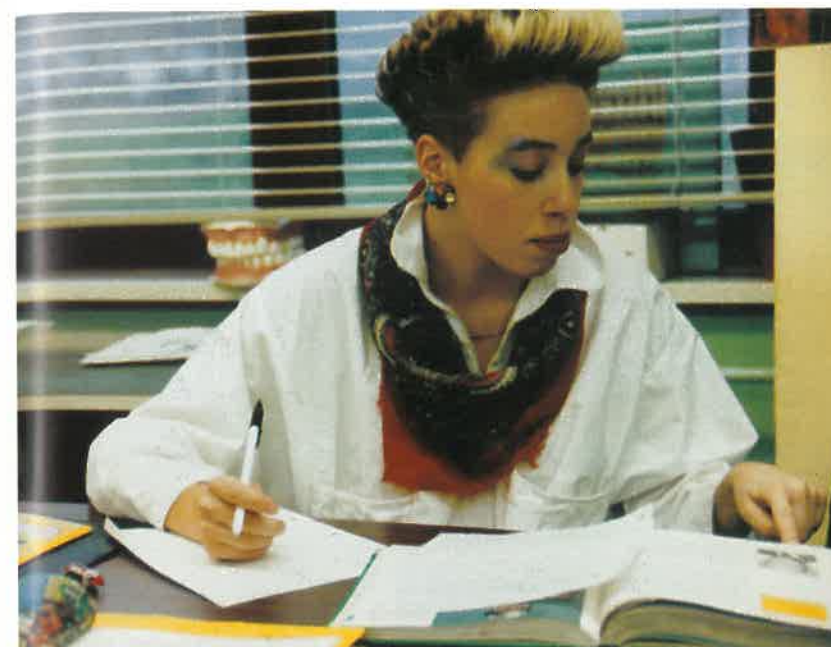

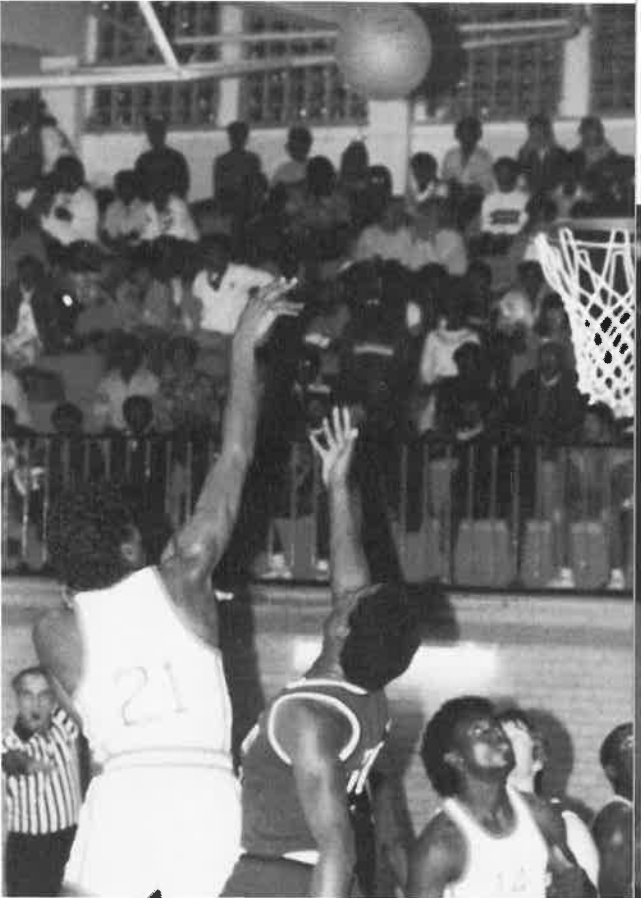

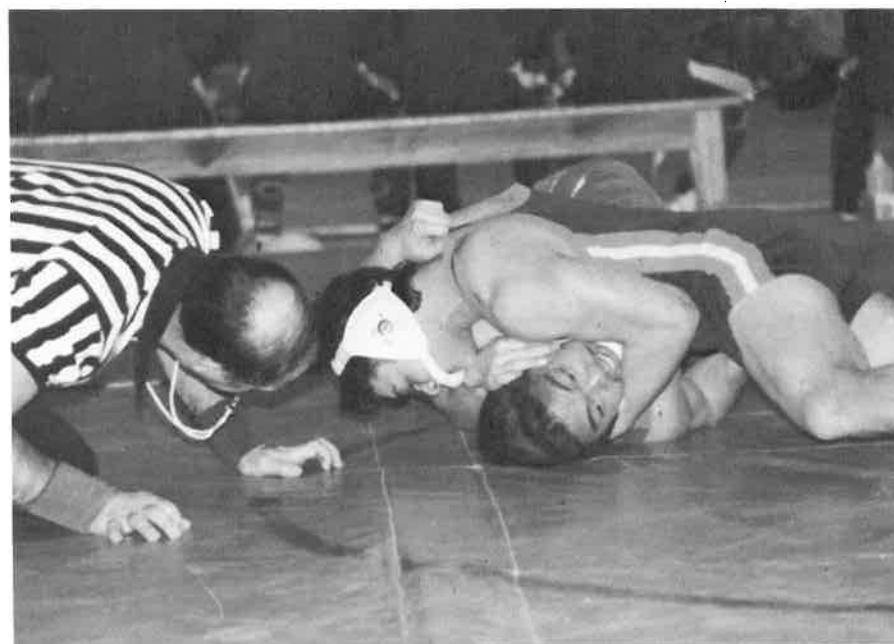

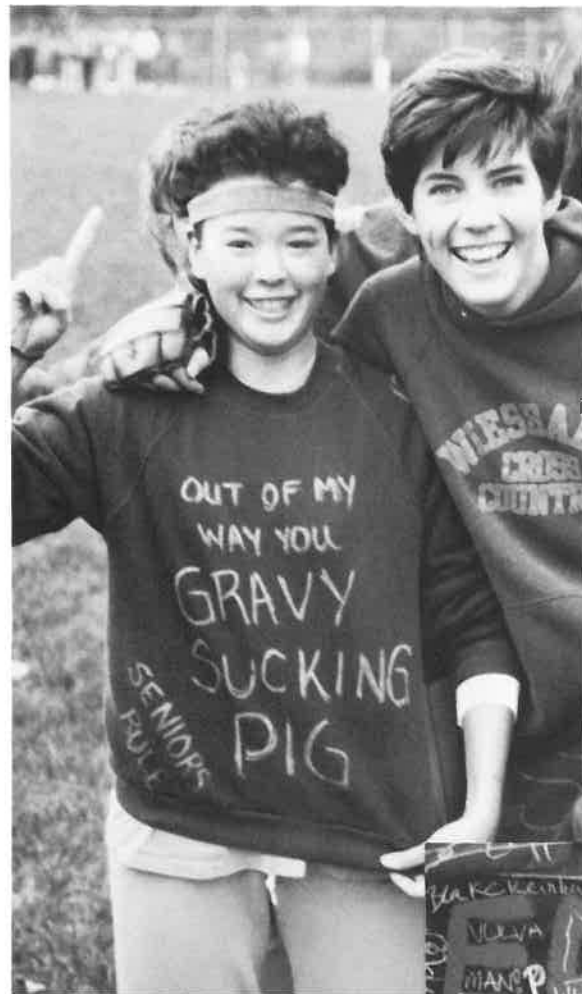
