











Koi Garden is a hand-cut collage commissioned by 1810 Gallery for the offices of California Medical Association in Sacramento, California. The original piece measures 48" x 48" and hangs in a diamond shape (right). Here, it has been tightly cropped and converted to illustrate a circular puzzle. Due to the repeating elements and areas of solid color, this would be a wonderfully challenging puzzle. It would also work in a square format.





Feathered Fins is a digital work created for Tannehill-Caldwell's 2020 solo show, "Magical Thinking," at Sparrow Gallery in Sacramento, California. The full piece measures 18" x 36" but can be cropped in several ways to fit a standard puzzle size. This example highlights an 18" x 24.5" section of the original.


