Completeness of application: All sections of application completed with thorough information and clear description of project, needs, and outcomes.	15
Application clearly describes the organization and demonstrates expertise in the Core Public Health Service area proposed.	15
Application clearly demonstrates how the intended project/activity and outcomes may improve the delivery or outcomes of the Core Public Health Services and, ultimately, better health measures.	15
Application clearly demonstrates a history in providing similar services or related work.	22.5

Proposal has a complete sustainability statement, clearly outlining a sustainability plan once the grant period has ended.	15
