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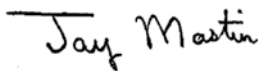

Day 1 | October 21

Depart your home city for Rome, Italy.

Day 2 | October 22 **D**

Civitavecchia, Italy | Embark

Arrive in Rome. Transfer to embark the *Wind Spirit*, settle in and unpack. Enjoy dinner on board this evening.

Day 3 | October 23 **B-L-R-D**

Bonifacio, Corsica, France

Bonifacio, on the French island of Corsica, has a truly dramatic natural setting, perched on high limestone cliffs. Begin your excursion with a tram ride from the harbor to Haute Ville (upper town) and around the plateau to enjoy the panoramic views. On your walking tour to the Citadel and Old Town see St. Dominique church; Place Bir Hakeim, St. Jean Baptiste church and a viewpoint overlooking Le Grain de Sable — a limestone rock formation. Explore the Jardin des Vestiges and see where Napoleon stayed.

Day 4 | October 24 **B-L-D**

Portoferraio on Elba Island, Italy

Stroll through the old town of Portoferraio, a vital trade center for Greeks and Romans in ancient times. Discover storied Medici fortresses; the Church of Misericordia; Forte Stella and Napoleon’s former home of Villa dei Mulini, among other historic sites. Peer through a stone gate with a magnificent sea view. Finish up with a walk along the town’s splendid promenade with its exclusive shops and boutiques.

Day 5 | October 25 **B-L-D**

Porto Venere for Cinque Terre | Portofino

Depart Porto Venere by private boat for an excursion to the UNESCO-inscribed Cinque Terre, a collection of five picturesque villages clinging to the cliffs over the Mediterranean Sea and connected by small footpaths. Visit the villages of Vernazza and Monterosso, and enjoy leisure time visiting the small shops tucked along the winding narrow streets. Late this afternoon, we will dock in Portofino, where you can go ashore and spend free time exploring. From every

Day 6 | October 26 B-L-D

Genoa

Choose an included excursion today in Genoa. During a walking tour through the old town, immerse yourself in the city's medieval core with its range of architectural styles, shops, restaurants and cafes. Marvel at the incredible Palazzi dei Rolli. Or enjoy a scenic drive to see the historic buildings. Both excursions end with food demonstrations and tastings.

Day 7 | October 27 B-L-D

Monaco | Nice, France

With an expert local guide in Monaco, stroll through the

old town's charming, narrow streets, admire the historic buildings and beautiful architecture. Visit the Cathedral of Our Lady Immaculate, where many of the Grimaldis are buried, including Grace Kelly and Rainier III. Tour the Prince's Palace, built as an Italian fortress in A.D. 1191. Marvel at the sumptuous décor in the State Apartments, home to Monaco's royals. Savor a delicious lunch on board as the ship sails to Nice, France. On a private, electric mini train, see some of the city's iconic highlights, including the colorful flower market, the Palais de la Préfecture and beautiful Baroque churches. Wind down narrow, shaded

streets and into sunny squares, then climb Castle Hill for a panoramic view overlooking the city and the beautiful blue water that the Côte d'Azur is named for.

Day 8 | October 28 B-L-D

Marseille for
Aix-en-Provence

Spend a leisurely day in Aix-en-Provence, birthplace of Paul Cezanne and known as "City of a Thousand Fountains." Stroll one of the most beautiful streets in France, the elegant Cours Mirabeau Avenue, lined with trees and 17th- and 18th-century mansions. Meander along winding alleys in the historic town center. Soak up lovely

architecture, parks, gardens — and of course, fountains — everywhere in this delightful city.

Day 9 | October 29 B-R-D

Port Vendres for
Carcassonne

Drive to Carcassonne,
a UNESCO World
Heritage Site and one
of the best-preserved
medieval cities in Europe.

Visit La Porte Narbonnaise, the Castle of the Counts and the Basilica St. Nazaire. Climb the ramparts and spy the watchtowers (the fortress has 52!). There's even a moat, nowadays filled with a lovely garden. Enjoy lunch on your own at one of the charming cafes within the walled city, and spend time visiting the galleries and shops. Tonight, join your

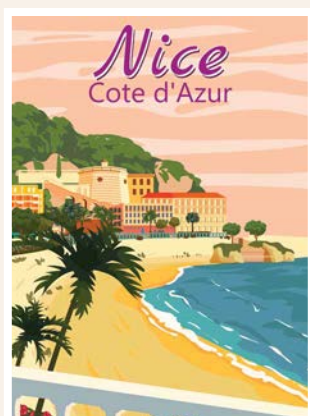
fellow passengers for a Captain's Farewell Reception and dinner on board.

Legends of La Côte d'Azur

In 1887, French writer Stephen Liégeard attempted to define the allure of a strip of Mediterranean coast between Marseille and Italy — an emerging winter destination for Europe's wealthy and elite. His book was titled “La Côte d'Azur” and from that time forward, this “short but delicious” route along the Riviera coast of France and Italy would become known as such. English aristocracy began flocking to the area as early as the 18th century for a luxurious respite in what was often referred to as a coastal “garden of Eden.” The addition of a railway line in the mid- to late-19th century ensured access to a dazzling enclave

of grand hotels and casinos that are now known collectively as the “Rivieras.” Today, these sparkling coastlines famously epitomize a glamorous age that captured the popular imagination in everything from F. Scott Fitzgerald's novel “Tender is the Night” to the 1955 film set in Monaco, “To Catch a Thief” (starring American actress Grace Kelly, who became princess of Monaco!).
