# CURRENT VACANCIES

One (1) State Court Administrator or designee

Two (2) members appointed by the Minnesota League of Cities representing the interests of city attorneys, at least one of whom must be a city attorney – **1 vacancy**

Two (2) members appointed by the Minnesota Chiefs of Police Association, at least one of whom must be chief of police – **1 vacancy**

Two (2) corrections administrators appointed by the Association of Minnesota Counties, representing the interests of local corrections, at least one of whom represents a Community Corrections Act County (MACCAC) – **1 vacancy**

Two (2) probation officers appointed by the Commissioner of Corrections in consultation with the president of the Minnesota Association of County Probation Officers (MACPO) – **1 vacancy**

Four (4) public members appointed by the Governor for a term of six (6) years, one of whom represents the interests of victims, and one whom represents the private business community who have expertise in integrated information systems – **1 vacancy**

Two (2) members appointed by the Minnesota Association for Court Management, at least one of whom must be a court administrator – **1 vacancy**
