Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Emergency managers serve Minnesota and the nation by responding to countless emergencies and disasters each year, demonstrating commitment, compassion, and professionalism in protecting the public; and
- WHEREAS: The efforts of emergency managers across our state have helped millions of people recover, rebuild, and become more resilient in the face of adversity; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota recognizes the emergency managers in every sector who work diligently to prepare, protect, and serve our cities, counties, the state, Tribes, regions, and organizations against hazards and risks.
