

Minnesota Office of Justice Programs (OJP)

SART Technical Assistance Program Standards

1. Provide technical support to Minnesota SART sites and other related multidisciplinary teams across Minnesota working to improve the response to sexual violence.
2. Create tools, methods, training, and concepts to assist multidisciplinary teams and allied professionals in advancing the victim-centered, trauma-informed, and offender-focused response to sexual violence within their communities.
3. Gather information and resources related to emerging issues, strategies, solutions, and problems surrounding the community and criminal justice response to sexual assault to inform development of timely and relevant resources.
4. Develop, implement, and maintain ongoing communications strategies to ensure the growth of multidisciplinary teaming in Minnesota.
5. Work with OJP to support the progress of OJP-funded SART team sites according to team standards.
6. Use \$25,000 of the award for special project funding to SART teams.
7. Provide outreach and assistance to under-resourced CCRT, CCR, SMART, SART, and/or MRT teams focused on sexual assault response.
