Out of state dealer license application

Dealerships in Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wisconsin may apply to issue Minnesota license plates and temporary permits to Minnesota residents who purchase vehicles from their dealership (Minn. Stat. section 168.002, subd. 6).

If your application is approved, you will be granted access to Electronic Vehicle Title and Registration (EVTR) and Vehicle Title Application and Permit (VTAP) transactions.

Submit your application

Along with this form, you will need to provide a copy of your dealer license from Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota or Wisconsin. There is no fee to apply.

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What is the purpose of supplying the information?

The information provided on this form is classified by 18 U.S.C. § 2721 (Federal Driver Protection and Privacy Act), Minnesota Statutes chapter 13 (the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act), and Minnesota Statutes section 171.12; the information may be released in accordance with these state and federal laws. DVS may also release the information pursuant to a subpoena or court order, or to a state or legislative auditor.
