Step 2 -Adjustment to Base

<u>Past Participation</u>:

Non-Car Rental

Our past participation is reflective of the fact that we currently have an ACDBE joint venture. Prior to that we had an ACDBE prime concessionaire in the Food & Beverage/Retail/Vending concessions at FWA for 10 years. This attainment was achieved based on race neutral good faith effort outreach by the Authority. As part of our proposal solicitation, we utilize extensive outreach to attempt to attract a wide range of interest in our opportunity (to include our current ACDBE provider). Since our significant past achievement is primarily a reflection of race neutral attainment, we don't believe that an adjustment for past participation would be a representative adjustment to the race conscious portion of the goal.

Car Rental

We have not made an adjustment for past participation because it included participation by an ACDBE car dealership which is no longer in existence. Therefore, we do not believe that our past participation would be an appropriate representation of our new goal structure and have not made an adjustment on this basis.

When examining the major economic contributors listed above, it becomes evident that economic disparity exists in Allen County, Indiana between the two major minority groups when compared with statistics for the majority group. Income, education, and employment disadvantage are areas that would impact an individual's ability to obtain funding and training necessary to own and manage a business eligible to participate in the ACDBE Program. As we have done previously, we would recommend a 1.0% individual contract adjustment to compensate for this disparity.

Attachment 5 Breakout of Estimated Race-Neutral & Race Conscious Participation Section 23.51

The Fort Wayne-Allen County Airport Authority will meet the maximum feasible portion of its overall goal by using race-neutral means of facilitating ACDBE participation. The Fort Wayne-Allen County Airport Authority uses the following race-neutral measures to increase ACDBE participation

- 1. Locating and identifying ACDBEs and other small businesses who may be interested in participating as concessionaires under 49 CFR Part 23;
- 2. Notifying ACDBEs of concession opportunities and encouraging them to compete, when appropriate;
- 3. When practical, structuring concession activities so as to encourage and facilitate the participation of ACDBEs;
- 4. Providing technical assistance to ACDBEs in overcoming limitations, such as inability to obtain bonding or financing;
- 5. Ensuring that competitors for concession opportunities are informed during presolicitation meetings about how the sponsor's ACDBE program will affect the procurement process;
- 6. Providing information concerning the availability of ACDBE firms to competitors to assist them in obtaining ACDBE participation;

Non-Car Rental

We estimate that, in meeting our overall goal of 1.86% we will obtain 1.86% from race-conscious participation. If an ACDBE prime concessionaire wins the competitive solicitation, we will substantially exceed our goal. While we will do substantial outreach to provide awareness of our opportunity (including our existing concessionaire), we cannot guarantee that an ACDBE firm will be selected. If they are not, it is anticipated that the goal will be met through goods and services since we only have one opportunity for our food & beverage and retail concessions. Due to limited ACDBE goods and service suppliers in Indiana, it is anticipated that this goal would be met through race conscious measures if the concessionaire is not an ACDBE.

Car-Rental

We estimate that, in meeting our overall goal of 1%, we will obtain 1% from race-conscious participation.

The Fort-Wayne Allen County Airport Authority has previously had limited success obtaining ACDBE participation in its car rental concession program. While we did have participation of a fleet supplier in previous years, this supplier is no longer eligible to participate in the program. Therefore, we will continue to include contract goals in our bid process to obtain good faith efforts toward ACDBE participation attainment in this area.

In order to ensure that our ACDBE program will be narrowly tailored to overcome the effects of discrimination, we will adjust the estimated breakout of race-neutral and race-conscious participation as needed to reflect actual ACDBE participation (see 26.51(f)) and we will track and report race-neutral and race conscious participation separately. For reporting purposes, race-neutral ACDBE participation includes, but is not necessarily limited to, the following: ACDBE participation through a prime contract that an ACDBE obtains through customary competitive procurement procedures; ACDBE participation through a subcontract on a prime contract that does not carry ACDBE goal; ACDBE participation on a prime contract exceeding a concession specific goal; and ACDBE participation through a subcontract from a prime contractor that did not consider a firm's ACDBE status in making the award.

We will maintain data separately on ACDBE achievements in those contracts with and without concession specific goals, respectively.
