Eligibility Requirements

- All participants are encouraged to apply, must live in the Greater Fort Wayne area.
- Participation is open to all regardless of age, race, color, sex, national origin, religion, ability, sexual
 orientation, gender identity and/or expression, status as a veteran, or any other federal, state, or locally
 protected class.
- Talents may include (but not limited to) singing, dancing, instrumental music, skits, magic, comedy, martial arts, juggling. Subject to approval by Center Stage Committee and the Clyde Theatre venue.
- One submission per talent act, whether in a group or individual act. Talent acts who are part of a group act should submit their participation forms together.
- Everyone must return a completed and signed Center Stage Talent Show Participation form with video submission by April 12, 2024. Acts with any member under 18 years of age must have a written consent from parents for each of the members.
- Recommended length of submission is 3 minutes, not to exceed 5 minutes due to file size limitations.
- In all cases, decisions of the judges are final.
- This is a family friendly, community event, so all content must adhere to a PG rating. No obscene language, no references to drugs, weapons, nudity, etc. All performances will be screened for appropriateness by the Center Stage Committee.
- Acts are responsible for their own props and costumes.
- All acts must be available and present in person at the Clyde Theatre starting at 12pm on Thursday,
 June 13, 2024.
- There will be a First Place \$5,000 cash prize for the winning act.
