Applications

Privacy is a priority to our company and all our subsidiaries. This Statement of Privacy applies to <https://ecnarudne.com/> and governs data collection and usage. This agreement was written in accordance to all state and federal guidelines at the time of publishing. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to ECNARUDNE includes <https://ecnarudne.com/>.

Purpose The ECNARUDNE website is a new and existing client management and marketing site. By using the ECNARUDNE website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement. Collection of your Personal Information In order to better provide you with products and services offered on our Site, ECNARUDNE may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- - First and Last Name
- - Mailing Address
- - E-mail Address
- - Phone Number
- - Discord.com information
- - Anonymous browser and mobile device data

All information collected by us is shown above unless you voluntarily provide more information to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services available on the Site. Billing and credit card information

third-party processors. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction and all information is protected through all steps of checkout.

Use of your Personal Information

ECNARUDNE collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

ECNARUDNE may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from ECNARUDNE and its affiliates.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

ECNARUDNE does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

ECNARUDNE may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to ECNARUDNE, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by ECNARUDNE. Use of Cookies
