How We Obtain and Use Information

Collection of information by Us in connection with this Website falls into two principal categories: (1) information voluntarily supplied by visitors to and Users of this Website, and (2) tracking information recorded as visitors and Users navigate through the Website. Some of this information is personally identifiable information in that it is information that may identify, or can be used to identify, the particular person to whom such information pertains, such as, for example, name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, social security number, and credit card information, but much of the information collected through or by this Website is not personally identifiable.

- **Sources of Personal Information**

Certain information, including Personal Data, is collected directly (actively) from You when You:

- Register for an account;
- Communicate with Us, such as to provide feedback, request support, or ask for additional information;
- Use Our Products or Services;
- Subscribe to newsletters, register for seminars or training, or purchase goods or services;
- Use interactive or social networking features of our Services, including setting up a public profile, interacting with Our community platform or forum, submitting content (such as comments, articles, links, or other items), or using our chat feature; or
- Otherwise interact with or access Our Services or Products.

The Company also may collect information, including Personal Data, from our affiliated entities. For example, You may sign up for newsletters with one of our affiliates and in so doing choose to receive information from us as well.

In addition to the above, We collect certain information, including Personal Information, from and about You automatically (passively). This information may include information about Your use of our Services or Products, Your use of other websites, as well as Your interests and preferences. For example, We may collect information about Your browsing and usage history on this Website. We may receive information, including Personal Data, from third parties who provide services to Us. We may combine the information We obtain from third parties with information that We or Our affiliates have collected about You.

Certain features available within the Products or Services will require you to submit PII about Yourself as a condition of participation. Some of the features may be offered by Us, while others may be offered by third parties. (For example, you may be required to submit PII in order to request information and offers from Us and Our partners.) When You choose to submit PII to a third party in connection with Your use of the Products or Services, the third party's privacy policy, rather than this Privacy Policy will control the use of your PII. - **Categories of Personal Data**

The Personal Data collected (electronically, in writing, or otherwise) by Us from You includes:

- Contact information (such as name, e-mail address, mailing address, and phone numbers);
- Payment information (including credit card information, billing address and bank account information);
- Account log-in information and credentials;
- Purchase or Product/Service use history;
- Information about Your interests, hobbies, trading background;
- Demographic information (such as number in household, information on Your income and assets, age, etc.);
- Photographs, images, video and other user-generated content such as materials that You may submit for contests or sweepstakes or interactive features; and
- Data gathered by technology when You visit Our Website or other platforms or forums (such as Your IP address).

Most of the above Personal Data collected is submitted voluntarily (actively) by You. Note that You may choose to share information with third parties by clicking on links to those third parties from within the Services or Products. In addition, You may elect to share information, including PII, through the Products or Services – for instance, posting comments on comment boards or interacting with Our community forums and platforms. Some of your activity on these Products/Services, including content You have posted, is public by default. Some of this content may include PII.

While most of the above Personal Data is collected voluntarily, there are exceptions. Regarding the above, The exceptions are (i) purchase or Product/Service use history and (ii) data collected by by technology when You use the Website or Our platforms or forums (such as Your IP address). Other information about You collected automatically (passively) is set forth below.

- **Automatically-Collected Information (Data Technologies)**

Like most website operators, We collect information from You automatically as You use Our Website and Products/Services of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available. This information is collectively from You passively, and it provides information about Your activities on this Website . As described below, such information may be collected through the use of cookies, clear gifs or web beacons, local shared objects or flash cookies, or through other identifiers or technologies, including similar technologies as they may evolve over time. We refer to these technologies collectively as “**Data Technologies**.” The information we collect through Data Technologies includes:

- Your browser type;
- Information regarding Your internet service provider or the type of device You used to access this Website,
- Your language preferences,
- Pages visited, and
- The date and time of each page request.

There is information that we collect automatically from You that may be considered Personal Data under applicable laws. For example:

- Your IP address. An “IP address” is a number that is automatically assigned to Your computer when You use the Internet.
- “Cookies” (or “browser cookies”). This Website may use certain software technology known as “cookies.” Cookies are small pieces of data (text files) that are stored by a User’s web browser

on the User's hard drive where it can be used to identify Your computer. These pieces of data take up very little room on Your system. Cookies are used to store certain "session" data or information about the User, such as the User's preferences.

- Flash Cookies. Certain features of Our Website may use local stored objects (or "Flash cookies"), which use Adobe Flash Player, to provide special content, such as video streaming, video on demand, video clips, or animation. Flash, and similar applications, use Flash cookies to collect and store information about Your preferences and navigation to, from, and on Our Website, including certain settings, preferences, and usages. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser cookies. Flash cookies are managed directly through Adobe's websites, rather than through your web browser.
- Web Beacons And Click-Stream Data: Web pages on Our Website, including third party advertisements and/or offers, may contain non-visible electronic images (sometimes called "web beacons," "web bugs," "single-pixel GIFs" or "clear GIFs") that allow the Website to access cookies or to count users who have visited particular pages on the website.
- Purchase or Product/Service Use History. When You use or access Our Products or Services or make purchases, We may have information regarding Your history of such uses and/or purchases.
- **Our Community Forums/Platforms**

As mentioned above, You may elect to use Our interactive community forums and platforms, which are part of Our Products/Services. These forums and platforms may message boards, chat rooms, comment boards, and reviews, or other platforms or forums that enable Users to post a comment or otherwise to communicate with each other. We are under no obligation to moderate or edit the forums and will not be responsible for the content or use of any material posted on any forum within Our Products/Services. We retain the right to delete at any time and for any reason any material posted within the Products/Services. If You do not wish to share PII on Our community

platforms and forums, You should be mindful not to post any. You are responsible for what You post or upload.

- **How We Use Information We Collect**

We use the information We collect from You while You are using the Website in a variety of ways, including using the information to customize features available to You, to customize advertising and offers that may appear on the Website; and to make other offers available to You via e-mail, direct mail, or otherwise. We also may provide Your information to third parties, such as service providers, contractors, and third-party publishers and advertisers for a variety of purposes.

Specifically regarding Your PII, We use Your PII for the purpose of conducting Our business and pursuing legitimate business interests. For example, We use Your PII to:

- Create and manage Your account;
- Provide the Products and Services You request;
- Tell You about other Products and Services that may be of interest to You (You can opt out of receiving such communications by following instructions provided in the communication);
- Process payments for purchases You have made (including for subscription packages for Our Services or Products);
- Enroll You in contests, programs, or other offers You request;
- Facilitate communication from third parties to You at Your request;
- Protect against or identify possible fraudulent transactions;
- Analyze the use of Our Services or Products;
- Understand and analyze how you arrived at Our Website or began using Our Products or Services;
- Manage the Services and Products, including the Website;
- Enforce Our Terms of Use;

- Enforce the terms of this Privacy Policy or Our other documents and policies (including the General Disclaimers Regarding Trading and Investments).

As indicated above, some of this data We collect may also be sent to third-party content providers (for example, advertisers, website analytic companies, etc.) that provide content for or on our Services or Products. Such sharing may allow the website and/or content providers to track You over time and across multiple websites. At this time, our Website does not respond to Do Not Track beacons sent by browser plugins as there is not yet a common agreement about how to interpret Do Not Track signals from browsers. Additionally, if You navigated from or navigate to other websites from our Website, We may collect the address of those websites.

Please see below in “How We Protect Personal Information” for other ways We may use Your information (including PII).

As indicated above, some of the information We collect about You is via Your use of Our Website and Products/Services through Data Technologies. We use Data Technologies to help us identify and track visitors, their usage of our Services, and their website access preferences.

For example, with regard to cookies, they help Us to customize and personalize Our Website for You and to make its navigation easier. They also help Us to track information so that We can, for example, estimate the number of persons that use Our Website and determine which areas of the Website are the most popular. Cookies make it easier for a User to move from web page to web page and to complete commercial transactions over the Internet. Cookies themselves do not necessarily contain personal information. Cookies may be used to enable a website to link a User’s use of the website with personal information provided by a User. Thus, unless You register for an account with Us, the cookie will not provide Us with any personally identifiable information about You, such as Your name or address. Third party advertisers, service providers, or websites that are accessed from links on this Website may also place cookies on Your computer. We do not have control over these

cookies or responsibility for information collected through them. We advise You to read the privacy policies of these third-party advertisers, service providers or websites to learn their respective privacy policy and practices regarding cookies and other matters. Most Web browsers are set up so that they will initially accept cookies, but You may be able to modify the browser preferences to issue an alert to You when a cookie is downloaded. Some Web browsers provide You with the ability to turn off or refuse cookies. However, if You turn off, reject or refuse cookies, some of the features of this Website (or other websites) may not function properly, and You may not be able to use many of Our services or features. Also, please note that, if You turn off, reject or refuse cookies, the security of Your account may be affected, since it will be more difficult for Us to know if Your account has been hacked or otherwise compromised.

With regard to web beacons and click-stream data, as indicated above, these non-visible electronic images (sometimes called “web beacons,” “web bugs,” “single-pixel GIFs” or “clear GIFs”) allow the Website to access cookies or to count users who have visited particular pages on the website. These web beacons, used in combination with cookies, help Us to understand the behavior of visitors and Users. HTML-formatted e-mail messages (messages that include graphics) also may contain web beacons that allow Us to determine which e-mail messages were opened and whether a message was acted upon, as well as to access cookies and count users. Information that We use from a technology like this that tells Us how visitors use this Website (for example, which pages they view, which links they use, and which search terms they put in) is called “click-stream data.” Click-stream data helps Us to determine what is important to You and what is not. It helps Us to decide what content and features to add and what to discard. It also helps Us to determine whether Our Website is easy to use or whether We need to redesign certain pages or links. While click-stream data does not typically identify a User personally, We may combine navigational information that We collect during Your visit to this Website with Personal Information that You provide.

We may allow third parties to use Data Technologies on our Website. The information collected from these Data Technologies may be shared with and

used by Us, by others acting on Our behalf, or by third parties. Information collected by Data Technologies may be used on this Website or on other websites, services, or online applications, including websites that may not be operated by Us. For example, We may partner with third party ad networks to either display advertising on Our Website or to manage Our advertising on other sites. These ad-network partners use Data Technologies to collect information about Your activities on this and other websites to provide You targeted advertising based upon Your interests. These websites and third-party ad networks are not controlled by Us.

You may be able to restrict our use of certain Data Technologies, such as cookies, by modifying your browser settings. For example, your web browser may enable you to refuse cookies. By restricting Our use of Data Technologies, certain features of Our Services and Products may not function properly.

Third Party Use of Cookies and other Tracking Data Technologies

Some content or applications, including advertisements, on the Website are served by third-parties, including advertisers, ad networks and servers, content providers, and application providers. These third parties may use cookies alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking Data Technologies to collect information about You when You use Our Website. The information they collect may be associated with Your Personal Information or they may collect information, including Personal Information, about Your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide You with interest-based (behavioral) advertising or other targeted content. We do not control these third parties' tracking Data Technologies or how they may be used. How We Protect Personal Information

BECAUSE YOUR PRIVACY IS IMPORTANT TO US, WE DO NOT RENT, SELL, GIVE, SHARE, TRADE OR PROVIDE IN ANY WAY THE PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION, INCLUDING E-MAIL LISTS, THAT WE OBTAIN ABOUT YOU THROUGH THIS WEBSITE TO THIRD PARTIES UNLESS YOU REQUEST OR PERMIT US TO DO SO, IT IS ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY TO PERFORM THE REQUESTED SERVICE, OR THE DISCLOSURE IS PERMITTED OR REQUIRED BY LAW.

We take reasonable precautions to ensure that User account information is kept private. We use reasonable measures to protect User information that is stored within Our database, and We restrict access to User information to those employees or other services providers who need access to perform their job functions, such as Our customer service personnel or Our technical staff.

Please be aware that We cannot absolutely guarantee the security of User account information, nor can anyone. Unauthorized access or use, hardware or software failure, viruses, and other circumstances may compromise the security of this Website and of User information at any time.

As for Our uses, as indicated above, We use Personal Information collected from You only as needed in an effort to keep it safe. Thus, we may use Personal Information as needed to provide information, offerings, and Products/Services requested by You and to create the best User experience possible for You. For example, We need to use Personal Information to complete Your registration and to create Your account. The information You provide during that process ensures that We can provide You with a unique and secure account that is customized for You.

In addition, We may need to use Personal Information to process and complete transactions that You choose to enter into on or in connection with this Website, to provide customer service, to conduct credit inquiries, to carry out Our obligations and enforce Our rights arising from any contracts entered into between You and Us (including for billing and collection), to perform research and analysis aimed at improving Our services and technologies, and

to display content that is customized to Your interests and preferences. We also may use Personal Information to register You for certain sweepstakes or contests that you have voluntarily entered. We may use e-mail addresses or other Personal Information to respond to User comments and questions, to send newsletters or other information, to notify You about recent transactions, to contact contest or sweepstakes winners, or to send any other communications to You.

In addition, We may use Personal Information to contact Users with offers and information about events, offerings, and Products/Services from other organizations We believe may be of interest to Users. We also may use Personal Information collected from You to improve content and functionality of this Website, to better understand Our visitors, to improve Our offerings and Products/Services, to market Our events, offerings, and Products/Services to Users, or to personalize this Website to meet the specific needs of the User.

With these various goals in mind, We also may compile data in an aggregate form that allows Us to understand Our Users better. Such aggregate data is anonymous and does not contain any PII (personally identifiable information) about the Users. By way of example, compiling aggregate data will allow Us to produce reports, if We choose, on a variety of things, including the most popular search terms by collecting general search term data from individual User searches.

Please see below for more information about how we use and protect Your information.

- **We Encrypt Personal Information and Utilize The Most Advanced Security Tools And Technology; We Will Notify You If Possible In the Event of a Breach**

We utilize a number of operational functions to protect the confidentiality of Your Personal Information. For example, We store Personal Information that We collect about You on computer systems with limited access that are located in secured facilities. Our employees and service providers are given

access to PII only to the extent they have a need to know such information. Thus, Our employees and services provider do not have access to Your sensitive Personal Information, unless it is necessary. Also, We and Our payment-processing service providers use the most advanced, industry-standard encryption technologies to transmit sensitive PII, such as credit card numbers, and, in all cases, We follow generally accepted industry standards and take commercially reasonable efforts to protect Your Personal Information.

In short, We use the most advanced technologies and security tools used in the industry to protect Your Personal Information. However, there is no such thing as perfect security, and We cannot, and do not, represent or warrant that this Website or Our transmissions of information to others are impenetrable or invulnerable to hackers. Thus, while We do as much as We can to protect Your Personal Information, We cannot absolutely guarantee the complete security of Our server, nor can We absolutely guarantee that information You supply will not be intercepted while being transmitted over the Internet.

- **Disclosing/Sharing Personal Information**

To further protect Your Personal Information, as indicated above, no one has access to it, unless absolutely required. Our employees and service providers are given access to PII only to the extent they have a legitimate business need to know such information.

As already described, We may disclose certain aggregated information about Our users and information that does not identify a particular individual for a variety of reasons.

- **Retention of Personal Data**
