

Questions to Draft a Customized EULA for Bandit Bot

1. Type of License:

- Is the license per user, per device, or is it a general subscription license?
- Are users allowed to access the service from multiple devices using the same account?

2. Scope of Use:

- Is the service strictly for personal use, or can it also be used for business/commercial purposes?

- Do you want the termination clause to allow immediate suspension of service if terms are violated?

9. Jurisdiction:

- Which country's laws will govern the EULA? For example, will it be governed under U.S. laws or specific state laws?

10. Special Features or Use Cases:

- Does Bandit Bot include unique features (e.g., deal alerts, scraping tools) that should have additional usage restrictions?
- Are there specific risks involved in using the product that should be highlighted in the EULA?
