Water - Homeowners must notify the Water Department as to date and time the water is to be turned on. Renters must deposit \$75.00. The deposit is retained until the final bill is rendered.

Water & Sewer bills are to be paid at the Village Clerk's Office. All accounts are billed quarterly with rates as follows: The minimum charge is \$28.08 (12,000 gallons or less). The sewer charge is \$5.28 for the first 6,000 gallons per quarter, plus .67¢ for every additional 1,000 gallons.

The Police Department has 70 squad cars to insure your protection. The Crime Prevention Unit produces the monthly Neighborhood Watch Report distributed in 33 participating neighborhoods and runs a variety of programs to reduce the possibility of crime. The D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) program teaches sixth-grade students to recognize and deal with the pressures that lead to experimentation with alcohol and drugs. OF SPECIAL IMPORTANCE

Vandalism by Minors - The Village has enacted an ordinance which makes parents and guardians responsible for acts of vandalism by children under their control.

Curfew Ordinance - Young people under the age of 18 must not be on the streets after 10:30p.m. (except on Fridays and Saturdays and days before National Holidays when the curfew is extended to 11:30p.m.).

Parking Ordinance - It is unlawful to park overnight on the street from 2:00a.m. to 5:00a.m. Parking is not permitted after one-inch snowfall and is never permitted on parkways. Permission may be received to park overnight from the Police Department for extra-ordinary circumstance.

Burning - NO burning of refuse, garbage, or leaves is permitted.

Bus Service for seniors and the handicapped available Monday-Friday 9:00a.m. to 3:00p.m., excluding holidays. Reservations should be made 24 hours in advance, 48 hours for doctor appointments.

For ages 55-65, fare is \$1.30 per ride. Age 65 and over with a RTA reduced fare card is .65¢ per ride without card is \$1.30 per ride. Handicapped fare is .65¢ per ride with handicap card, regardless of age.

HEALTH SERVICES

Orland Township Health Services provide low cost, high quality medical exams to *all Tinley Park residents*. Forty area doctors participate in this program, which is designed to encourage residents to maintain their good health by seeing a doctor on a regular basis for preventive health care.

To utilize this service, the resident visits the township office at 15100 S. 94th Avenue, Orland Park, to pay for the exam and select a doctor from a list of those who participate. Appointments are scheduled by the resident with the doctor's office. Physical, dental, vision, hearing and podiatry exams and screenings are available at reduced rates. Free blood pressure screening clinics are scheduled monthly and numerous free children's immunization clinics are scheduled throughout the year.
