



The Village of Tinley Park is governed by a Village President (Mayor) and six Trustees. Together they comprise the Board of Trustees which determines policies, enacts ordinances and sets the policies for village services and procedures.

An appointed Village Manager carries out policies, prepares budgets and hires and directs paid personnel.

A Village Clerk records minutes of Village Board meetings, supervises local elections, and processes official records.

The President, Clerk and Trustees are all elected at large to four-year terms. The Village Board meets on the first, second and fourth Tuesdays of each month at 8:00 p.m. at the Village Hall. The next municipal election is April 7,1987.

Voter Registration

New residents (18 years and older) may register to vote at the Village Hall after 30 days. Proof of residency is required. For election information or absentee ballots, please call the Village Clerk, 532-7700.

Vehicle Licenses Required

All motor vehicles registered in Tinley Park must display a current municipal sticker. The stickers are available at the Village Hall. They go on sale December 1st, and must be displayed by February 28th of each year. New residents or residents buying a new vehicle have 30 days to purchase the license.



Dog Tags

All dogs in Tinley Park must have a municipal tag. The tags are available at the Village Hall for \$3.00. They are due by January 1st of each year. Proof of rabies innoculation is required.

Building Permits Required

Before any new residential or commercial construction, residents should contact the Building Department at 532-3425, to see if a permit is required.

Smoke Detectors Required

The Village of Tinley Park requires the installation of smoke detectors in single and multi-unit dwellings.

Open Burning Prohibited

Open burning (including leaves & garbage) is prohibited in Tinley Park.



Leadership in Orland Park is provided by the Village President and six Village Trustees. Each board member is elected to a four-year term. The Village Manager is hired by the Village Board. As chief administrator, he oversees the daily operations of the village. While doing this, the manager must adhere to the guidelines established by the Village Board through the policies it adopts. This type of government enables the residents to be served by both the leadership experience of elected officials, along with the administrative skills and experience of the Village Manager.

In Orland Park, the office of the Village Clerk is a four-year elected position. Present at all Village Board Meetings, the clerk is the official record keeper for the



The regular meetings of the Village Board are held every Monday at 7:00 p.m., with the exception of holidays. The meetings are held at the Village Hall, 14415 Beacon Avenue. Residents are encouraged to attend these meetings. The next municipal election is April 7, 1987.

Voter Registration

Residents (18 years and older) may register to vote at the Village Hall, 14415 Beacon Avenue and at the Orland Township Office, 15750 S. Harlem Avenue, after 30 days. Proof of residency is required. For absentee ballots or election information, contact the Village Clerk at 349-5400.

Vehicle Licenses Required

All motor vehicles registered in Orland Park must display an annual vehicle sticker. The stickers are available at the Village Hall and must be displayed by January 1, of each year.

RTA Bus Service

The Public Services Department provides RTA Bus Service for all Village of Orland Park residents, Monday through Saturday, from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The bus travels only within the corporate limits of the Village of Orland Park. Twenty-four hours advance notice is preferred for an appointment. Further information is available by calling 349-5430.

Garbage Pick Up

Garbage pick up within the Village of Orland Park is provided by H & R Refuse. Residents may obtain further information by calling 388-4445.

Dog Tags

Dog tags are required for all dogs in the Village of Orland Park. Tags are available at the Clerk's Office in December and are valid for the following year. A valid rabies certificate must be presented at the time of purchase. The fee is \$2.00. Dog tags that are purchased late cost \$5.00.

Bicycle Registration Required

Bicycles must be registered with the Police Department. The annual registration fee for each bicycle is 50°.

Midlothian Ordinances & Licenses

Voter Registration

New residents (18 years and older) may register to vote at the Village Hall after 30 days. Proof of residency is required. For absentee ballots or election information, contact the Village Clerk at 389-0200.

Vehicle Licenses Required

All motor vehicles registered in Midlothian must display an annual village vehicle sticker. The stickers are due January 1, of each year and are available at the Village Hall. New residents or residents purchasing a new vehicle have 30 days to purchase the license. Senior Citizens (age 65 or older) receive a discount.

Smoke Detectors Required

The Village of Midlothian requires the installation of smoke detectors in all businesses and private residences.

Special Permits Required

Permits are required for the installation of any supplemental heating source. This includes wood-burning stoves, furnaces and fireplaces. Call the fire department at 389-0200, for more information.

Bicycle Registration

Voluntary registration of bicycles is available at the police department during regular business hours. An identification tag is affixed to the bike.

Pet Licenses Required

All dogs and cats must be licensed by the village. The collar tags are available at the Village Hall and are due by May 1, of each year. Proof of rabies innoculation is required.

Garage Sale Permits Required

Midlothian residents must secure a permit to host a garage sale. The permits are \$2.00 per year and each household is limited to one garage sale per year.

The village administration is comprised of eight elected officials; a mayor, a clerk and six trustees. The mayor is also known as the Village President. The trustees are similar to aldermen or councilmen and are elected at large from within the village. Each trustee chairs a committee and sits on two others. The mayor is an ex-officio member of all committees. These committees are concerned with specific areas of village administration, such as Finances, Public Works, Permits and License, etc. The mayor oversees the workings of these bodies and coordinates their activities. The Village Clerk is responsible for the day-to-day business of the village such as preparation of minutes of meetings, sale of vehicle stickers, animal tags and voter registration.

Village Board Meetings are held on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at 8:00 p.m., in the Village Hall. All meetings are open to the public and your involvement is encouraged. If you wish to make a presentation, please contact the Village Clerk in advance.

Westhaven Ordinances & Licenses

Voter Registration

New residents can register to vote after 30 days at the Village Administration Building. Proof of residency is required. The next municipal election is April 7, 1987. For election information or absentee ballots, contact the Village Clerk.

Vehicle Licenses Required

All motor vehicles registered in Westhaven (Orland Hills) must be licensed by the village. The vehicle stickers are available at the Administration Building and are due on January 1, of each year. New residents or residents purchasing a new vehicle have 30 days to obtain the license.

Construction Permits Required

Most forms of home improvements require a building permit. Permits are required for the erection of garages, swimming pools, fences, sheds, patios, driveways, sidewalks, room additions and most electrical, plumbing and furnace work.

If you have any questions as to whether or not you need a permit, please contact the Clerk's Office or the Building Commissioner.

Pet Licenses Required

Each family is limited to no more than four dogs or cats. All animals within the village, over four months old, must wear a village tag. These annual licenses can be obtained at the Village Administration Building and are due by March 1. Proof of rabies innoculation is required.


The mayor and 14 alderman compose the City Council which enacts ordinances, manages finances and sets policies for city services and procedures.



Vehicle License Required

All motor vehicles registered in Oak Forest must display a current vehicle sticker. The stickers are available at the Clerk's Office and must be displayed by July 1, of each year. New residents or residents buying a new vehicle have 30 days to buy the village license.

Dog Licenses Required

All dogs must be licensed by the village. The annual tags are available at the City Clerk's Office for \$5.00 each. Proof of rabies innoculation is required.

Bicycle Registration

Voluntary registration of bicycles can be done at the City Clerk's Office. There is no charge for this service.

Garage Sale Permits Required

Oak Forest residents are limited to three garage sales per year. Homeowners must apply for a permit at the City Clerk's Office. There is no charge for the permit.

Building Permits Required

Any new building, additions, fences, pools, garages, renovations of any kind (in excess of \$1.00) is regulated by City Ordinance and requires a permit. Contact the Building Department at 687-4050, for more information.

Parking Ordinance

All vehicles must be removed from the city streets for 12 hours following a snowfall in excess of two inches.

Smoke Detectors Required

The city requires the installation of smoke detectors in all businesses and private residences.

Branch Pick Up

The city will pick up debris from trees and shrubs twice a year - for a two-week period in the spring, and again for a two-week period in the fall. The refuse company which services the city does pick up tree trimmings and branches from pruning as a regular part of their contract with the city. However, the debris must be cut to four-foot lengths and tied.





The Tinley Park Fire Department has 65 volunteer fire fighters.

Emergency equipment includes five pumpers, a 65-foot snorkel, a 100-foot aerial ladder truck, and five specialized pieces of fire-fighting equipment.

The Fire Prevention Bureau is responsible for the annual inspection of all commercial and multi-unit apartment buildings within Tinley Park. The Bureau is also active in educating the community about fire safety.

During Fire Prevention Week (October 7-13, 1985), the Department hosts open house at both of its facilities. The Fire Prevention Bureau visits local schools, businesses and industries with demonstrations and discussions about fire safety.

Home Fire Safety Surveys are available free of charge to all Tinley Park residents. An inspector will look for potential fire hazards and offer advice on how to improve those elements-call 532-5656.

Members of the Fire Prevention Bureau will counsel children about playing with fire at the request of the parents.

Each fall, the Bureau offers a Babysitter's Class on how children should be handled in various types of emergencies. The sitter must pass a test on the course material to receive a certificate of completion.

Children, families and groups can adopt a fire hydrant in their area, to ensure quick access, in case a fire emergency occurs. Residents adopting a fire hydrant take responsibility for keeping it free of debris, weeds and trash during the warm weather and free of snow in the winter months. A record of adopted hydrants will be kept at the Department.

The Crime Prevention/Community Relations Bureau offers programs and services geared toward community awareness and fighting crime.

The Orland Fire Protection District serves the village of Orland Park, Westhaven and the unincorporated areas of Orland Township. If you are not certain of which fire protection district serves your home, please call 349-0074.

The district staff includes 21 full-time fire fighters and 40 paid-on-call personnel. The 61 member force includes 28 certified paramedics, 24 emergency rescue technicians (ERT's), 16 emergency medical technicians and four State of Illinois fire safety instructors.

Every fire occurence in the district is investigated for cause and origin by a Fire and Arson Team (two policemen and two firemen) certified by the State of Illinois.

Emergency equipment includes: four pumpers, a 100-foot aerial ladder truck, two light-duty rescue squads, three advanced life-support ambulances, a hose truck and a tanker truck.

The Orland Fire District has a Fire Prevention Bureau that consists of a full-time supervisor and two inspectors. The bureau is responsible for inspecting the safety of all commercial buildings within the district.

A Fire Prevention Bureau representative can offer advice on home fire hazards and quick escape routes to district residents through the free, home fire safety survey.

Free blood pressure screenings are available at either fire station from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., seven days a week.



The Oak Forest Fire Department consists of 15 fulltime firefighters and 40 paid-on-call personnel.

Emergency equipment includes five pumpers, a snorkel truck, a rescue truck, an all-purpose pickup truck, two advanced-life-support ambulances and a basic-life-support ambulance.

The Oak Forest Fire Prevention Bureau offers several programs and services that educate the public about fire safety.

The bureau participates in Oak Forest's Safety Tour; by teaching stop, drop and roll and other fire safety tips to younger children.

The bureau makes regular visits to area pre-schools, day-care centers and elementary schools with a Fire Prevention Puppet Show. Several of the schools participate in the bureau's poster coloring contest during Fire Prevention Week (October 7-13, 1985).

Children, families and/or groups can adopt a fire hydrant in their area to ensure quick access, in the event of an emergency. Persons adopting a hydrant take responsibility for keeping it clear of debris, weeds and trash during the warm weather and free of snow in the winter months.

Free Home Fire Safety Surveys are available to all Oak Forest residents. A department representative will check your home for fire hazards and offer tips on how to remedy the problems.

A vacationer's smoke detector kit is available to any resident leaving on vacation.

The Fire Prevention Bureau offers free classes on the use of fire extinguishers for any local business or civic organization.

The bureau also has spokespersons available to speak on any fire or safety-related subject, call 687-6050.

Free blood pressure screenings are available at either station from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The Crestwood Police Department has 35 sworn police officers. Five marked patrol cars cover a four-square-mile radius, 24 hours a day.

The department offers several programs and activities geared toward the prevention of crime.

The juvenile officer makes regular visits to Crestwood schools with discussions and presentations on Stranger Danger, bicycle and pedestrian safety and alcohol and drug abuse.

Cooperating with I-SEARCH (Illinois Enforcement Agencis To Recover Children), the department originates "Operation Kid" (fingerprinting) for the state's network of information and each child's parent.

The community relations division sponsors annual Bicycle Rodeo for the safety of all bike owners. Each participant is tested on their knowledge of bike safety. Each bicycle is then inspected for defects or needed repairs.

A Police Cadet Program, coordinated through the Boy Scouts of America, is available for boys and girls, 15-20 years old, interested in a law enforcement career.

Crestwood's Block Parent Program enables its residents to be an immediate source of help for someone in distress. This well-organized program has over 250 block parents, a regular newsletter and regularly scheduled meetings.

Crestwood's Neighborhood Watch Program is originated by the Community Relations Bureau. The program should reach every resident in 1985 with a packet of information about reporting suspicious activities. Regular meetings are held with several senior citizen groups and homeowner associations.

Crestwood residents may have the physical safety of their dwelling checked free, through the Home Security Survey. A department representative will check windows, locks, landscaping and lighting and then offer suggestions on how to improve these elements.

The department offers free use of their engraving tool to mark all of your valuables. For more information on any of the Police Department services, please call 371-4800.

Commuter Bus Service

Pace And Metra Serve The Southwest Suburbs

The southwest suburban communities benefit from a coordinated system of transit bus, specialized van and commuter rail service. Bus service is provided by Pace, the suburban bus service of the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) and commuter rail service is provided by Metra under the commuter rail division of the RTA. Bremen and Orland Townships, as well as the villages of Crestwood and Tinley Park, provide specialized van services.

The Village of Tinley Park is currently served by Pace bus route 364. Route 364 - 159th Street, serves Brementowne Mall, the Fulton Commons and Tinley Park Hospital, and other locations from 183rd and Harlem to River Oaks Plaza.

Tinley Park also has paratransit available to seniors (65 and older) and mobility limited residents. The service provides door-to-door transportation. More information on this service may be obtained by calling the village at 532-7700.

Orland Park is served by three routes. Route 384-Narragansett/Ridgeland serves various points in the southwestern suburbs from Orland Square to Ford City. Route 835 Chicago Express picks up commuters on the west side of Orland Square, then at the Norfolk and Western Station. This route stops at another 5 locations throughout the south suburbs, ending its run in downtown Chicago at the Palmer House. This service is available only on weekdays.

Route 386-Harlem travels from the Blue Island Station stopping at Orland Square and ending at Archer and Harlem.

The Village of Orland Park has a paratransit service available to residents of Orland Park and Westhaven. For more information on this service call 349-5430.

Oak Forest residents are served by three different bus routes. Route 364-159th Street takes residents from 159th and Cicero to River Oaks and points between to Tinley Park Hospital. Route 383-Cicero begins at 159th and Cicero and makes various pulse points to Ford City.

Route 740-Oak Forest is a feeder service to the Rock Island Station. This is an AM/PM rush hour service only. This route is scheduled to feed trains leaving Oak Forest at 6:31, 6:58 and 7:48. This route meets the trains leaving downtown Chicago at 4:35, 5:16 and 5:40 p.m.

In Midlothian, Pace operates 2 buses. Route 359-Robbins and South Kedzie has its north terminus at 119th and Halsted with its south terminus at South Suburban Hospital. Route 383-Cicero operates from Ford City Shopping Center to Oak Forest Hospital at 159th and Cicero. The route goes from 147th up to Playfield Plaza and Jewel on Route 83.

Three Pace buses are operated from Crestwood. Route 359-Robbins and South Kedzie operates on Kedzie with its north terminus at Halsted, and its south terminus at Orland Square. Also, Route 383-Cicero operates on Cicero from Ford City Shopping Center to Oak Forest Hospital. Lastly, Route 386 operates with a north terminus at Ford City and a south terminus at Orland Square.

The Village of Crestwood runs a paratransit bus for residents. Details of this service can be obtained by

calling 371-4800.

Bremen Township has a paratransit service for senior (55 plus) and mobility limited. Call 687-8223 for further information.

Orland Township Senior Citizen Council has a station wagon servicing seniors (60 plus). Further information may be obtained by calling 429-3800.
