

Village Board

Government by the people and for the people is more than an ideal in Tinley Park. Since the village was established over 100 years ago, its citizens have been actively involved in determining the community's needs and future.

Tinley Park has a consensus form of government with a mayor, clerk and six trustees, elected for four-year staggered terms. Village officials are independent of political parties and affiliations and are elected at large from the entire community.

The elected officials are advised by 10 committees whose members are appointed on a non-partisan basis. Over 200 volunteers regularly gather in committees to study, analyze and recommend action to the Board of Trustees on a wide variety of community interests.

Committee meetings are always open to the public and to new volunteers. Residents are encouraged to get involved in a committee or to attend village board meetings.

The effectiveness of the village government, the success of the numerous community-wide events, and the lively participation of so many of its citizens not only gives Tinley Park an interesting past and an effective present, but what promises to be an exciting and progressive future as well.





lice officers to take their police cars home. The officers can use the cars within the village during off duty hours. This keeps the police cars in evidence and acts as a strong deterrent to crime within the community. Members of the police force must live in Tinley Park.

Fire Department

Fire prevention in Tinley Park is insured by over 90 volunteers who rapidly respond to any emergency. As with the Police Department, all it takes to bring out the fire trucks is a call to 911.

Among the many tasks of the three full-time personnel is to coordinate training, maintain equipment, check for building code violations, and educate Tinley Park school children in fire safety.

Vehicle stickers

All vehicles owned by residents of Tinley Park must display an annual village sticker. Stickers are sold from December 1 to February 28 for \$15. After March 1, the price of the sticker increases to \$24. Trucks must also display a village sticker. The cost depends on the weight of the vehicle.

Senior citizens (over 65 years of age that year) receive a discount on the stickers. The cost is only \$1.50 until March 1 when it increases to \$3.

Parking ordinances

Unless special permission is received from the Police Department, it is unlawful to park on the street in Tinley Park from 2 a.m. to 5 a.m. or after a one-inch snow fall. It is also unlawful to park on parkways.

Water Department

Tinley Park is growing in leaps and bounds and the water department has planned ahead. Currently, Lake Michigan

Tinley Park keeps growing

According to Tinley Park Village Clerk Frank German, the recent 1992 special census is already out-of-date. He predicts that in the next special census the population of Tinley Park will reach 42,000. "There are close to 2,500 more people in Tinley Park, based on occupancy permits and it is still growing."

With the end of World War II and the baby boom that followed, according to German, "there has been a

surge in development."

water, stored in two elevated tanks and two ground reservoirs, is distributed through a renovated pump house. An additional pump house and reservoir are planned to meet the community's future needs.

Dog licenses

Each year, dog owners must register their pet with the village, prove rabbis vaccination, pay \$3 and receive a dog

The Animal Control Officer operates within the village, retrieving stray dogs and setting traps for unwanted wild animals. The officer may be contacted by calling 532-9111.

Burning regulations

Cook County law does not allow the burning of refuse, garbage or leaves.

Curfew ordinance

Tinley Park enforces an 11 p.m. curfew for anyone under the age of 18 Sunday through Thursday evenings. Curfew on Friday and Saturday nights is midnight.

Garbage removal

Garbage removal is available to single family residents from Tinley Park Disposal, 532-8787. Service is unlimited if trash is contained properly. One large item per week will be p.m. and from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays. The phone removed with the trash. Bills are issued quarterly.



Tinley has strong ties to Bruedingen, Germany

Village Trustee Pat Rea's military service in Germany brought Tinley Park an unexpected and delightful new ally.

While stationed near Bruedingen, a city located near Frankfort, Germany, Rea was able to make contact with the local royal family. This initial contact led to visits by Tinley Park residents seeking their German roots. In 1988, Prince Ferdinand and Princess Elizabeth of the House of Ysenburg and Bruedingen enjoyed Tinley Park's Oktoberfest celebration.

These early exchanges led to greater contact and friendship between the two cities. In 1989, 153 residents of Bruedingen, including some members of the royal family and the Bruedingen band, came to Oktoberfest.

That year, there was more to celebrate. Tinley Park and Bruedingen singed the documents officially tying the two communities together in a Sister City partnership.

Since then, exchanges between the two cities have flourished. In 1992, nearly 300 citizens of Bruedingen joined Tinley Park for their Centennial celebration. In 1994, almost an equal number of Tinley Park residents visited Germany.

These exchanges fostered strong friendships between the two communities. Visitors stay in host families' homes and enjoy their family life while they learn and enjoy a new culture.

"The concept behind the sister City program is to create world peace, one family at a time," explains Reta Brudd, "It is hard to make war on friends."



Tinley Park Public Library

The Tinley Park Public Library has embraced the old formats and the new technologies to help guide residents

into the twenty-first century

Serving the people of Tinley Park and Orland Hills, the Public Library is located at 17101 71st St., Tinley Park. As a member of the South Suburban Library System, its library cards may be used at a network of libraries throughout the area.

Filling the shelves of the Tinley Park Library are over 96,000 volumes, 450 periodicals and nine newspapers. Users may visit library sections based on age; from children through adult areas, and interest; from reference to fiction.

The library is also equipped with over 1000 compact discs. A core collection of records not available in CD form has also been retained. A wide selection of books on audio cassette for listeners of all ages is also available. Over 1600 video cassette tapes may be rented for \$1 each for up to one

week to library patrons.

Modern technologies that increase access to information have been made readily available at the Tinley Park Library. Four INFO-TRAC terminals provide quick and convenient access to a wide variety of magazines. Three microfilm readers and printers make newspaper access easier. Two IBM compatible computers, electric typewriters and photo-copiers are also available at the library. World wide FAX facilities for public use are offered at \$1 per page

Although many services are offered year round, the Tinley Park Public Library enhances their service with special and

seasonal programs available to people of all ages.

The "Tinley Tourist" for children ages 8 to 12 proved so popular in its first year that more sessions were added.


Pre-schoolers have a wide array of story hours to attend in the mornings. Families listen together during the eve-





Tinley Park recycling efforts a success

The success of Tinley Park's recycling efforts can be measured in the amount of waste materials that get removed, remade and reused rather than thrown away. The community's response has grown with each passing year. Currently, participation in the recycling program averages 85 percent of Tinley Park's single family homes.

On the same day as trash pick-up, special trucks gather a wide variety of materials that formerly rested in land fills. Recyclable materials currently include glass, tin and aluminum cans, plastic bottles with #1 or #2 markings, all newsprint, phone books

and shiny, glossy magazines.

According to Tom Agema, general manager of Tinley Park Disposal, "We hope to include more items in the

Although every homeowner has a blue, 18-gallon recyclables bin, additional bags or boxes filled with recyclables may also be put out for collection. Recyclable materials may be deposited at the Recycling Drop-Off Center at the Public Works garage, 183rd and 80th

Since 1990, Illinois residents have had to separate yard waste from garbage for either composting or special disposal. From April through November, Tinley Park residents can bag leaves and clippings for removal on their usual garbage days. Bags may be purchased from local merchants and no stickers are necessary. A 90-gallon cart may also be purchased from Tinley Park Disposal to hold yard waste for removal.

Sticks bundled in 3 to 4-foot lengths will also be re-

moved.



Tinley Park's history goes back more than century

Tinley Park may have celebrated its centennial a few years ago, but according to local historian Brad Bettenhausen, "The town is really older than that. The village was officially established in 1853.

Although Native Americans may have hunted in the area, the first permanent settlers located in Bachelor's Grove three miles north of Tinley Park in the late 1820's. By 1853, the existence of a Chicago Rock Island and Pacific Rail Road station drew those farmers and many more settlers to the new village of New

The town thrived and grew as more settlers, particularly from Germany, came to the area. Dr. Moses Ballard ran the town's first post office. Sam Tinley and his sons worked for the railroad. Members of the Vogt, Andres and Fulton families were instrumental in the growth of the community.

By 1892, New Bremen was ready for a new town government and a new name. Henry Vogt was elected the first mayor and Tinley Park was officially established.

While there is no documentation to substantiate some community stories, folk tales about local history abound. One home in Tinley Park may have been a station on the underground railroad. The cemetery in Bachelor's Grove may be haunted. And who really built the Carl Vogt Building and when?

Recently restored, the Vogt building at Hickory Street and Oak Park Avenue is one of the most historic buildings in Tinley Park. It was built in 1871 when speculation was high that the Chicago and Decatur Air Line Railroad would interest with the Rock Island Railroad in Tinley Park. The planned railroad never materialized and the hotel later became the residence of the Vogt and Fulton families and later apartments. It now contains offices.

Historical societies

History is alive and well and living in Tinley Park. Together, the South Suburban Heritage Association (SSHA) and the Tinley Park Historical Society have uncovered the area's history, dispelled misconceptions and worked toward a better understanding of the past.

With more than 300 members, the Tinley Park Historical Society investigates the past in order to better understand the present. The Society meets at "The Landmark," 6727 W. 174th St., a Lutheran church built in 1884, at 7:30 p.m. on the third Wednesday of the month. Periodically throughout the year programs concerning local history are presented. The annual Christmas party at The Landmark kicks off the holiday season with an old-fashioned sing-a-long and story telling.

In addition to The Landmark, the Historical Society also maintains a museum featuring local information, heritage. and artifacts open Wednesdays between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. For more information, call 429-4210 or 532-7700.

The focus of the SSHA is to make people aware of and promote the history and heritage of the south suburban area through an annual conference, workshops, newsletters and an annual bus tour of the south suburbs. For more information call 614-8713.



The secret of the Tinley Park Youth Commission's success is learning what teenagers want before final decisions are made. To accomplish this, half of the members of the 12-member, all-volunteer committee are teenagers.

"The feelings of our teen members was that youths need an unstructured placed to hang out," explains Commission Chairperson Brenda Babjak. "These youths have structure

everyday. They need a place to get away from that."

The Teen Drop-In Center developed from this need. Located at the Park District's Vogt Woods Building, 6527 W. 171st Street, the Drop-In Center is open Wednesday and Friday evenings.

"The Center is rather unstructured with a pool table, video and audio equipment and refreshments," says Babjak. Anywhere from 10 to 40 junior high school and high school age youths use the facility at no charge.

Tinley Park is located at a Chicagoland crossroad, literally at a point where Interstate highways to the north, south, east and west converge.

Metra commuter rail system provides service to two stations in Tinley Park — downtown Tinley at Oak Park Avenue and 80th Avenue on the west side of town. Metra's Rock Island District trains connect Tinley Park with LaSalle Street Station in downtown Chicago and Union Station in downtown Joliet.

For those taking to the skies, O'Hare International Airport is about 45 minutes away, while Chicago's Midway Airport is about 20 minutes from Tinley Park. In addition, there are small airports in Frankfort and New Lenox which serve private and corporate aircraft.




