OF SPECIAL IMPORTANCE

VANDALISM BY MINORS - The Village has enacted an ordinance which makes parents and guardians responsible for acts of vandalism by children under their control.

CURFEW ORDINANCE - Young people under the age of 18 must not be on the streets after 10:30 p.m. (except on Friday and Saturday and days before National Holidays when the curfew is extended to 11:30 p.m.)

PARKING ORDINANCE - It is unlawful to park overnight on the street from 2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Parking is not permitted after one-inch snowfall and is never permitted on parkways. Permission may be received to park overnight from the Police Department for extra-ordinary circumstances.

BURNING - NO burning of refuse, garbage or leaves is permitted.
