

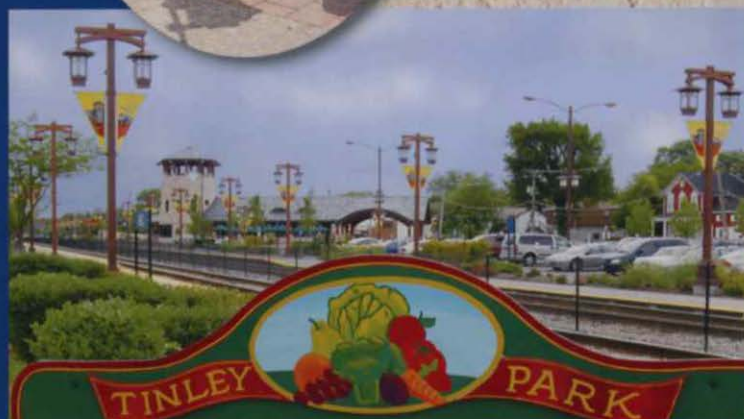

Holidays when the curfew is extended to 12:00 am)

Parking Ordinance

It is unlawful to park overnight on village streets from 2:00 am to 5:00 am.
Parking is not permitted after one-inch snowfall and is never permitted on
parkways. Permission may be received from the Police Department
to park overnight in an extra-ordinary circumstance.

Tinley Park EMA (fully accredited through the State of Illinois) provides emergency and non-emergency support to various Village Departments and community-based events in the area of disaster planning and management, emergency response, and disaster recovery. EMA maintains volunteers (men and women) interested in supporting the emergency management function of the Village.

The Village's outdoor Civil Defense Warning Sirens are located throughout the community and are tested on the **FIRST TUESDAY of each month at 10:30 a.m.** In the event of an actual emergency when the sirens are activated, citizens are encouraged **NOT** to call "911", but instead should turn on their radio or television for further information regarding current conditions.

<i>Tornado Warning Alert:</i>	3 minute steady blast (TAKE COVER)
<i>National Emergency Siren:</i>	3 minute wavering or intermittent blast (TAKE COVER)

Orland Township Health Services provide low cost, high quality medical exams to all Tinley Park residents. A large number of area doctors participate in this program, which is designed to encourage residents to maintain their good health by seeing a doctor on a regular basis for preventive health care.

To utilize this service, please visit the Orland Township Office (address above) to pay for the exam and to select a doctor from those on the list. Appointments are scheduled by the resident with the doctor's office. Physical, dental, vision, hearing and podiatry exams and screenings are available at reduced rates. (Physical screenings may not be used for an illness.) Free blood pressure screening clinics are scheduled monthly and numerous free children's immunization clinics are scheduled throughout the year. Proof of residency required.
